

**SAN JOSÉ UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT
BOARD OF EDUCATION
RESOLUTION 2025-04-24-03
AUTHORIZING THE COMPETITIVE NEGOTIATION PROCESS FOR
THE PROCUREMENT OF DISTRICT RADIO EQUIPMENT AND SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the State Legislature has recognized that it is in the public’s best interest to allow school districts to consider other factors in addition to price in the procurement of certain technological supplies, equipment, and services; and

WHEREAS, following the adoption by a school district’s governing board of certain findings, Public Contract Code section 20118.2 authorizes that procurement through a competitive negotiation and selection process; and

WHEREAS, the San José Unified School District (“**District**”) wishes to contract for the replacement of radio equipment, including delivery, licensing, programming, and maintenance services, as further described in **Exhibit A** attached hereto (“**Project**”); and

WHEREAS, the Project requires specialized equipment and services and qualifies for procurement through the legislatively authorized competitive negotiation and selection process set forth in Public Contract Code section 20118.2; and

WHEREAS, the District shall, after the competitive negotiation process, award contracts for the Project to the qualified proposer whose proposal is the most advantageous to the District with the price and all other relevant factors being considered; and

WHEREAS, the District will make every effort to generate the maximum feasible number of proposals from qualified proposers and, in the event that there is only a single response to the District’s request for proposal, the District shall make a finding to that effect before proceeding to negotiate; and

WHEREAS, in the event that the District does not award contracts to the proposer with the lowest price, the District shall make a finding setting forth the basis for the award.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is found, determined and resolved by the Board of Education of the San José Unified School District as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are adopted as true and correct.
2. The Project described in the recitals and **Exhibit A** is a procurement of equipment and services as described in Public Contract Code section 20118.2(b).
3. That equipment and services are not available in substantial quantities to the general public.
4. The Board finds that the District’s procurement of the equipment and services for the Project qualifies under Public Contract Code section 20118.2(b) for purchase through competitive negotiation and selection as described in Public Contract Code section 20118.2(d), and the Board authorizes that procurement.
5. The Superintendent, or designee, is authorized to engage in a competitive negotiation and selection process in compliance with Public Contract Code section 20118.2 for the procurement of the equipment and services.

6. The Superintendent, or designee, shall recommend to the Board a qualified proposer for award of contracts for procurement of the equipment and services, which contracts will be the most advantageous to the District with price and all other relevant factors being considered.
7. The Board reserves the right to reject all proposals submitted, pursuant to Public Contract Code section 20118.2.
8. The Superintendent, or designee, is authorized and directed to take all further actions as may be necessary or convenient to carry out the procurement of the equipment and services.
9. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION & PROJECT CRITERIA

- 1. Scope of Work.** The Project is for the replacement of the Risk Management Team’s current analog radios with seven hundred and sixty (760) digital portable two (2) way radios (“Equipment”) and the provision of licensing, programing, maintenance, and delivery services (“Services”).
