

## Methodology for Assigning Family Engagement Facilitators (FEFs)

To equitably allocate Family Engagement Facilitators across school sites based on English Learner (EL) enrollment, the following tiered assignment model will be used:

- Sites with more than 300 English Learners receive 1.5 FTE
- Sites with 50 to 300 English Learners receive 1.0 FTE
- Sites with fewer than 50 English Learners receive a minimum of 0.5 FTE

This approach ensures all schools receive foundational support while scaling resources in proportion to the level of student need. Based on the most recent information we have, these are the enrollment numbers of English Learners, by site, for the 2025- 2026 school year:

Charter schools are not included in this calculation, but can purchase their FEFs, following this tiered assignment model (proportionally), should they choose.
