

Updating Board Policy

As the only statewide organization representing the local school governance perspective, the California School Boards Association (CSBA) provides resources to help Local Educational Agencies (LEAs) fulfill their complex roles. CSBA provides a wider range of advocacy, leadership development, policy, information, financial, and other support services than any other education organization.

One of CSBA's main supports is in creating and updating LEA board policies (BP), which are aligned to the Educational Code.

SRCS uses the CSBA BPs templates to update their policies.

When SRCS updates our BP, here is the process that we use:

- CSBA updates a BP, called a 'CSBA Sample Policy'.
- SRCS takes our most current board-approved BP and compares it with the CSBA Sample Policy by striking through (Redline) old language and attaching it to the agenda item.
- When SRCS wants to add additional language that is not part of CSBA, we will add it in **BOLD** red lettering.
- Once approved, all the red is then converted to black lettering, and the additional language that is not part of CSBS will remain in **BOLD** font and will be uploaded to the Simbli/GAMUT Meeting platform.
