Measure Y parcel tax

As a result of the San José Unified community voting yes on Measure Y, the district has benefited from ongoing local funding to support our neighborhood schools since the 2017-2018 school year. This funding has been used for:

- maintaining and improving core academics in reading, writing, math, the arts, and science;
- improving programs to prepare students for college and 21st-century careers; and
- attracting and retaining high-performing teachers and educational staff.

For the 2025-2026 fiscal year, San José Unified has budgeted for the following expense in accordance with the commitments of the Measure Y parcel tax and aligned to the district's strategic plan:

- ✓ in support of college and 21st century careers, \$66,563 to ensure that all library and college and career centers are open throughout the school day.

The expenditures in 2025-2026 represent the use of the final Measure Y proceeds. All parcel tax revenues and expenses will continue to be overseen by San José Unified's Parcel Tax Oversight Committee (PTOC), an independent citizens' oversight committee.
