RECOGNITION OF INDIGENOUS PEOPLES' DAY
MONDAY, OCTOBER 13, 2025**

WHEREAS, West Contra Costa Unified School District acknowledges that Indigenous People are the true Native Americans, as they are the first inhabitants and caretakers of the land now called America; and

WHEREAS, WCCUSD recognizes and honors the land that is currently home to many past and current district-owned properties as historically aboriginal territories and Indigenous lands; and

WHEREAS, WCCUSD joins the President of the United States and the Governor of California by acknowledging, honoring, and celebrating the perseverance and rich diversity of Indigenous People, as well as the contributions and immeasurable positive impact that Indigenous People have made to every aspect of American society; and

WHEREAS, WCCUSD also joins the Governor of California in solidarity and support of Native- and Indigenous-led movements toward balance, reciprocity, and respect;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the West Contra Costa Unified School District Board of Education hereby and henceforth recognizes the second Monday of October as Indigenous Peoples' Day, and commend its observance to all members of the WCCUSD community.
