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The third edition of the AEFE-UNSS chess tournament in North America is being organized by the International School of Boston. This event is the first of the 2025-2026 season. The competition, which is both individual and team-based, is open to girls and boys in elementary and middle school.

The team event is a qualifier for the French School Championships of the French Chess Federation. Young International Reporters will be on hand throughout the event to cover the competition through interviews, photos, and videos shared on the AEFE-UNSS league's social media accounts in North America.

Promoting French-style school sports in a North American cultural context, this event allows participants from AEFE schools in Canada and the United States to exchange ideas and forge lasting bonds on and off the sports field.

For the 2025 edition of this tournament, schools from other AEFE zones are invited to participate.

Accommodation

Players and team chaperones may be filmed during the event for use in multimedia, internet, and video, and for the purposes of the media present during the tournament.

The cost is set at \$400 per person and includes:

- Accommodation for students and accompanying adults (one supervisor for every seven students), in rooms for four children and rooms for two adults.
- Meals from dinner on Sunday, November 9, 2025, to lunch on Wednesday, November 12.
- Transportation to and from Boston International Airport.
- Transportation to cultural sites. Evening entertainment. All costs associated with organizing the tournament.

Parents of delegations wishing to accompany their children will not be admitted to the International School of Boston and will be responsible for their own expenses (transportation, hotels, meals).
