Professional development, training & support materials, and online platform access to support the K-3 early-literacy after-school program.		Building on the successful results from the Elementary Academy program in Summer 2024 (average of 5.0 months of reading gains at BHES, and 4.7 months at ALES summer sites) and Summer and Fall 2025 programs, the District will offer a similar version of the program, in conjunction with our Boys & Girls Club after-school professionals at ALES, JMES, PTES, HLES, and SLES.		Background: In the Technical Analysis and Springboard Impact Reports presented at the 9.13.23 BOE meeting, results of the program revealed a statistically significant improvement in students' "Correct Letter Sounds" and "Words Correct Per Minute" metrics (from Summer, 2023). Also, some students showed up to a 5.9 month reading gain from participating in the intensive 5-week program. The results from the 2 Summer 2024 sites showed similar impressive gains in student scores. The program will again be monitored across several metrics and will include both descriptive and inferential statistics. Results will be summarized in an independent Impact Report.

Provide District-wide waste collection, recycling, and composting services.		At its meeting on December 8, 2021, the Board of Education approved a three-year contract with Recology with a start date of January 1, 2022. The initial term of the agreement was for a period of three (3) years with the option to renew for two (2) additional one (1) year terms based on Santa Rosa City Schools' discretion. At the time of the original Board approval, the Board was informed that the pricing would increase by about 2.5% in year four and by 2.5% in year five. On January 8, 2025, the District exercised the first additional one-year term. Business Services staff recommends exercising the second of the two additional one-year renewals, effective January 1, 2026, through December 31, 2026. An extension letter and the applicable rates for services are referenced in the attached contracts. 2026 billing will be adjusted accordingly in the event of reduced or no longer needed services due to school consolidations.		Recology Sonoma-Marín is to develop a diversion-driven outreach and education program for Santa Rosa City Schools. The diversion plan will help the District in reducing its carbon footprint and potentially save the District money.
