

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the DeKalb County Board of Education (“Board”) has determined that the cost of upgrading the Cary Reynolds Elementary Facility, Dresden Elementary Facility, Idlewood Elementary Facility, Jolly Elementary Facility, Sequoyah Middle Facility, and Stoneview Elementary Facility is greater than the state funding to replace these facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Board intends to tear down and replace the Dresden Elementary Facility, Idlewood Elementary Facility, Jolly Elementary Facility, Sequoyah Middle Facility, and Stoneview Elementary Facility; and

WHEREAS, the Cary Reynolds Elementary Facility, Dresden Elementary Facility, Idlewood Elementary Facility, Jolly Elementary Facility, Sequoyah Middle Facility, and Stoneview Elementary Facility will no longer be used for any K-12 school once their replacement facility opens; and

WHEREAS, the Cros Keys High Facility and Druid Hills High Facility are in need of modernization, including addition and extensive renovation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The DeKalb County Board of Education is phasing-out the current Cary Reynolds Elementary Facility, Dresden Elementary Facility, Idlewood Elementary Facility, Jolly Elementary Facility, Sequoyah Middle Facility, and Stoneview Elementary Facility.

DeKalb County Board of Education will modernize the Cross Keys High Facility and the Druid Hills High Facility.

The DeKalb County Board of Education withdraws all outstanding capital outlay applications for state funds for the above mentioned facilities.
