

Regulation 9150: Student Board Members

Duties of Student Board Member

The duties of the student Board member include the following:

1. To provide continuing input for Board deliberations.
2. To strengthen communications between the Board and district students.
3. To represent all students and facilitate the discussion of all sides of issues. This duty does not preclude the student Board member from stating his/her individual opinion.
4. Student Board member shall be seated as the chairperson to the Student Intra-District Leadership Council and the Alternate Student Board member shall serve as the vice chairperson.

Selection and Term of Student Board Member

The student Board member shall be selected by the Governing Board based on the following criteria:

1. Each District high school shall submit one candidate to the Board of Education. The selection team shall consist of: Assistant Principal, Activities, 1 school site teacher, and two students from the leadership body.
2. The Student Board member shall be selected by the Board of Education through an interview process.
3. The Board Interview team shall consist of at least 2 Board Members. All interviews shall be conducted by the same two members.
4. Each school's Student Board Member Candidate shall be submitted in writing to the Board of Education by the first meeting in April deadline for Board Agenda items.
5. The Board of Education will formally accept the candidate selection at the first Board meeting in April.
6. The term of office shall be July 1–June 30.

Vacancy

If the position of student Board member becomes vacant, the elected alternate student Board member shall resume the duties of the student Board member.

Selection and Term of Student Intra-District Leadership Council Members

1. Student Board member shall be seated as the chairperson to the Student Intra-District Leadership Council and the Alternate Student Board member shall serve as the vice chairperson.
2. The ASB President for each District high school shall represent their school on the Leadership Council. The ASB Vice President of each high school shall be the alternate in the absence of the ASB President.
3. Two additional representatives from each District high school shall serve on the committee. These representatives shall be appointed by the Assistant Principal of Activities. One representative shall be a Junior and one shall be a Sophomore. To insure diversity, representatives shall be appointed using the following criteria; male/female, class-level representation, racial ethnicity, and leadership skills.
4. The term of office shall be June through June.

Duties of Student Intra-District Leadership Council Members

To provide continuing input for Board deliberations the duties will include the following:

1. To strengthen communications between the Board and district students.
2. To represent all students and facilitate the discussion of all sides of issues. This duty does not preclude the

student Board member from stating his/her individual opinion.

3. Shall have regularly scheduled meetings.
4. Gather information from the school sites to identify issues to be discussed, pursued or resolved. The Student Board member will bring these issues to the Board of Education.
5. To facilitate a smooth transition, the outgoing committee members shall meet with the newly elected members in May/June.

Board Materials/Information

The Superintendent or designee's office shall provide the student Board member with full and complete agendas and copies of any materials received by the Board except for those materials covered in closed session and any other confidential materials. The Superintendent's office shall serve as the "home office" for the student Board member, where he/she may make use of secretarial facilities and receive advice and/or information upon request.
