

CHRONOLOGY OF THE AGENDA ITEM

After the May 24, 2016, approval of the 2017—2022 E-SPLOST V referendum by DeKalb voters, the Board approved an E-SPLOST V list of projects on December 5, 2016, for \$561 million to include various capital renewal, renovation, and classroom addition projects throughout the District.

On August 9, 2021, the Board approved the award of RFQu No. 21-752-034 for Professional Architectural and Engineering Services for Laurel Ridge Elementary School, Woodridge Elementary School, Chestnut Elementary School, and Druid Hills Middle School to Cooper Carry.

Based on the Architect's preliminary review and recent District initiatives, it is recommended that a fire sprinkler system, roofing improvements, replacement of existing lighting with LED light fixtures and ceiling replacement be added to the scope. Chesnut ES will be removed from project 10335 Sprinkler Installation C as it is a more efficient use of funds to include this work in project 37035.
