

## **CHRONOLOGY OF THE AGENDA ITEM**

After May 24, 2016, approval of the 2017—2022 E-SPLOST V referendum by DeKalb voters, the Board approved an E-SPLOST V list of projects on December 5, 2016, for \$561 million to include various capital renewal, renovation, and classroom addition projects throughout the District.

On August 9, 2021, the Board approved the award of RFQu No. 21-752-034 for Professional Architectural and Engineering Services for Laurel Ridge Elementary School, Woodridge Elementary School, Chestnut Elementary School, and Druid Hills Middle School to Cooper Carry.

Based on the Architect's preliminary review and recent District initiatives, it is recommended a fire sprinkler system, replacement of light fixtures with LED fixtures, roofing improvements and ceiling replacement be added to the project scope.
