

CHRONOLOGY OF THE AGENDA ITEM

At its business meeting on Monday, March 15, 2021, The DeKalb County Board of Education approved the **North Georgia Fuel Cooperative**, to purchase diesel and gasoline from James River Solutions, LLC as the primary supplier, Petroleum Traders Corporation as the secondary supplier and Colonial Oil Industries, Inc. as the tertiary supplier to the DeKalb County School District, for a one-year term with four one-year options to renew subject to Board approval on a year-to-year basis.

On October 18, 2021, the DeKalb Board of Education approved the first one-year extension of the North Georgia Fuel Cooperative agreement.

To address raising fuel costs, and to align the District extension with the purchasing cooperative Agreement, this agenda item seeks the Board of Education approval to supplant and replace the October 18, 2021, extension; to increase the spend amount to \$8,100,000; and to align the extension duration with the Cooperative's contract extension dates of March 1, 2022, through February 28, 2023.
