

Educational Film Agreement – Life At Your School

This Agreement (“Agreement”) is entered into by and between:

Faba Films

A filmmaker-led streaming platform providing mentorship, education, and distribution opportunities

The Joy Lab, Inc.

A non-profit organization that supports this project through its Restorative Joy Youth Project (RJYP), a youth-centered approach designed to center student voice, well-being, and authentic storytelling throughout the filmmaking process. EIN 33-4374956

and

Elsie Allen High School

Santa Rosa, California

collectively referred to as “the Parties.”

Purpose of the Agreement

The purpose of this Agreement is to outline a collaborative, educational film project (working) titled Life At Your School, designed to provide high school students with hands-on filmmaking experience, mentorship, and meaningful engagement around mental health, identity, and grief.

This Agreement is not a contract. It is a good-faith understanding between the Parties and may be discontinued by any party at any time.

Project Overview

- Project Series Title: Life At Your School, Episode Title: Life At Elsie Allen High ●
- Production Dates: June 15, 2026 – July 31, 2026
- Premiere Date: August 15, 2026
- Filming Hours: 9:00 AM – 3:00 PM
- Location: Elsie Allen High School campus, Santa Rosa, CA

The project will be filmed on campus during the summer of 2026 and will culminate in an on-campus red carpet premiere event.

Roles & Responsibilities

Faba Films Will:

- Provide experienced filmmaker mentors across directing, cinematography, editing, music, production, and post-production.
- Oversee the creative execution of the project alongside student teams. ● Provide non-exclusive distribution via the Faba Films streaming platform, where the completed film will be available free to watch globally.
- Ensure all participating students receive:
 - Film credit / job experience
 - A personalized letter of recommendation
 - A professional reference

The Joy Lab, Inc. Will:

- Provide behavioral scientists to support:
 - Character development
 - Narrative authenticity
 - Mental health accuracy and responsibility
- Serve as Head of Production, mentoring student production assistants. ● Ensure the project maintains an educational, trauma-informed, and student-centered approach.

Elsie Allen High School Will:

- Provide access to the following on-campus spaces:
 - One large gathering space (auditorium, gymnasium, or cafeteria)
 - Three classrooms
 - One hallway
 - Select outdoor areas as needed
- Silence the school bell during filming sessions
- Assist in identifying at least one daily chaperone, provided either by:
 - School staff, or
 - Parents/guardians of participating students

- Serve as a Producer on the project, with:
 - Final approval of the script
 - Final approval of the completed film cut
- Receive 100% of ticket proceeds from the August 15, 2026 on-campus red carpet premiere.
- Use of Name & Logo: Elsie Allen High School grants permission for Faba Films to use the school's name in the episode title and to include the school's name and official logos within the film and associated behind-the-scenes promotional content.

Student Participation

- The project is primarily intended for students entering 11th and 12th grade (Class of 2027 and 2028).
- If audition participation is limited, eligibility may be expanded to additional grade levels.
- All participating students will gain:
 - Hands-on film production experience
 - Professional mentorship
 - Resume-ready credits and references

Premiere & Community Benefit

- A red carpet premiere will be hosted on campus on August 15, 2026.
- Elsie Allen High School may sell tickets to the event.
- 100% of ticket proceeds will go directly back to the school.

Flexibility & Withdrawal

This Agreement is entered into in good faith.

Any party may withdraw at any time should the project no longer feel aligned, feasible, or appropriate.
