

CHRONOLOGY OF THE AGENDA ITEM

At its business meeting on Monday, March 15, 2021, The DeKalb County Board of Education approved the **North Georgia Fuel Cooperative**, to purchase diesel and gasoline from James River Solutions, LLC as the primary supplier, Petroleum Traders Corporation as the secondary supplier and Colonial Oil Industries, Inc. as the tertiary supplier to the DeKalb County School District, for a one-year term with four one-year options to renew subject to Board approval on a year-to-year basis.

On October 18, 2021, the DeKalb Board of Education approved the first one-year extension of the North Georgia Fuel Cooperative agreement.

On November 14, 2022, the DeKalb Board of Education approved the amendment of the first one-year extension from March 1, 2022, through February 28, 2023.

It is requested that the Board of Education approve the 2nd extension of the North Georgia Fuel Cooperative for the dates of March 1, 2023 through February 29, 2024.
