Shared Plates Strategies have historically provided support for the CNS program via grant funded programs offered by partner organizations focused on staff training, and local and organic food procurement. The CNS program anticipates greater savings through the formal bids in the broadline food, supplies, and milk categories.</p>		<p>Child Nutrition (CN) programs must offer formal bids for purchases over the small purchase threshold. The annual purchases of the SRCS CNS in the broadline food, supplies and milk categories will be in excess of the small purchase threshold, and therefore require a formal bid process for each category. CN programs have additional unique requirements related to formal bids, including the Buy American Act compliance, unique thresholds for perishable foods, delivery windows, and other CN program requirements. The CNS program will transition from a co-operative formal bidding model with regional school districts to a formal bid that aligns with the unique benefits of the CNS warehouse's capacity and infrastructure.</p>		SRCS CNS will evaluate the effectiveness of this contract through the completion and effectiveness of the formal bids for broadline food, supplies and milk.
