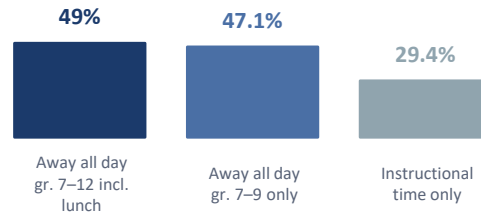
## Do you support more restrictions on mobile devices at the secondary level (grades 7-12)?

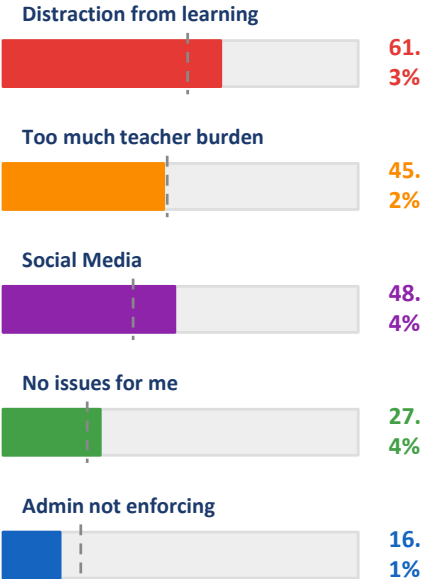

## What issues specifically are not working in your context?

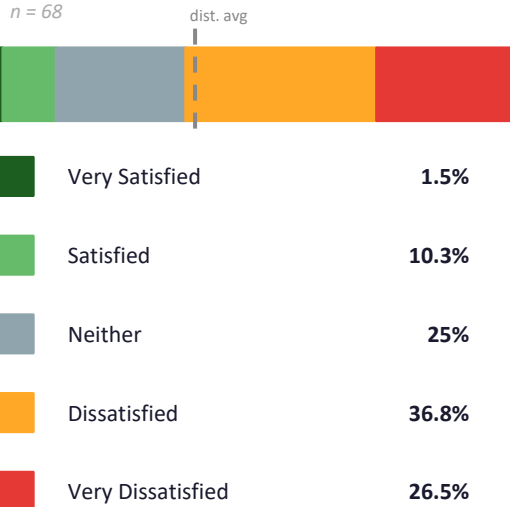

## How satisfied are you with this policy?



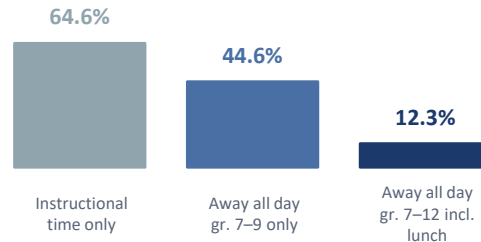
## Do you support more restrictions on mobile devices at the secondary level (grades 7-12)?

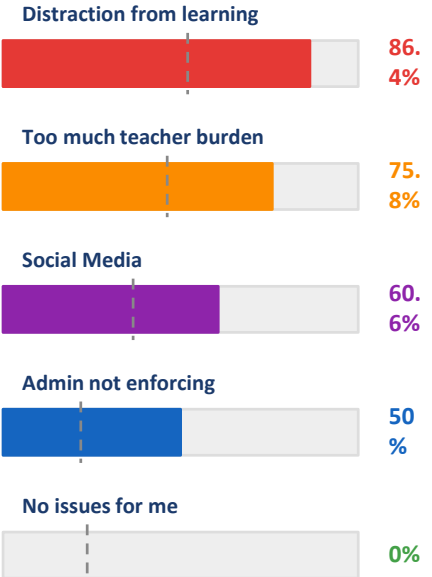

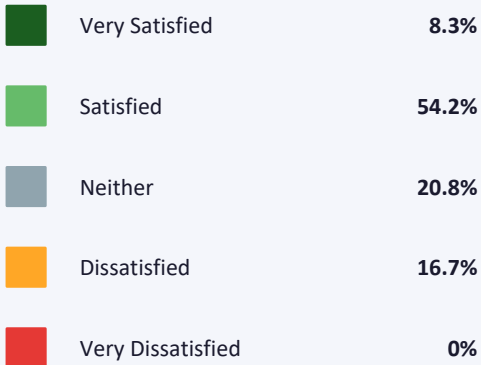


# Administrator Survey — Mobile Device Policy

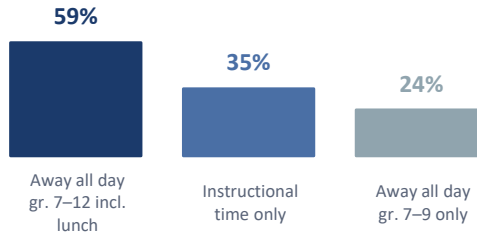
## Support More Secondary Restrictions?

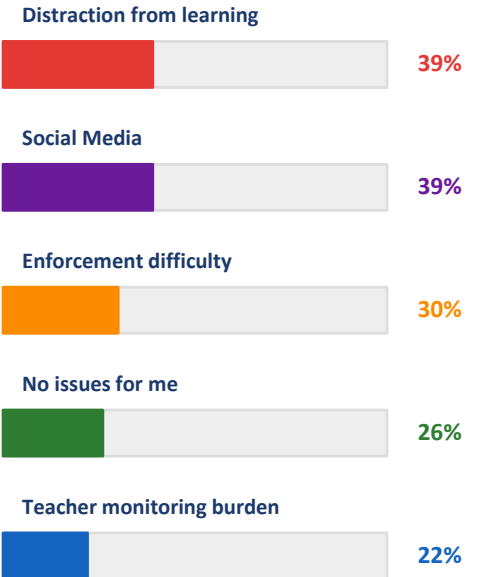
