

CHRONOLOGY OF THE AGENDA ITEM

In anticipation of the upcoming end of E-SPLOST V and the start of E-SPLOST VI, Operations' staff started investigating PMIS software systems in late 2021/early 2022 that would be District owned and used by both District and the E-SPLOST Program Manager staff. District staff evaluated PMIS software products from multiple vendors and selected Kahua due to its capabilities and ease of use. Additionally, the District was notified by ACERM that the current PMIS software, Proliance, will be retired by its parent company, Trimble, effective the first quarter of 2023.
