Approximately **88%** of enrolled students reside within the city of Santa Rosa, with the highest concentration in Santa Rosa and within a **3-5 mile radius** of the school. This reflects the school's ability to retain families by offering a program that is both engaging and meaningful for students across all grade levels.

12% Out-of-District Enrollment

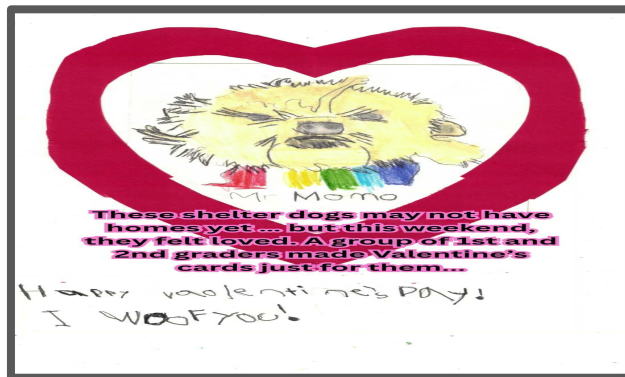
Approximately **12%** of our students come from outside district boundaries, including neighboring communities such as **Windsor, Healdsburg, and Cloverdale**. These families are actively choosing Santa Rosa Charter School for the Arts because of the distinctive opportunities our program provides.

Every Student Belongs Here

Currently, our site serves approximately **20% of our student population** with an IEP or a 504 plan.

Through our arts-integrated, project-based learning model, we support **full inclusion classrooms** where students learn alongside their peers in meaningful ways.

The Value of Arts Integration
