Board President José Magaña opened public comments regarding item L.1 at 6:20 p.m. The speaker was allowed two (2) minutes to address the Board.

Trustee Nicole Gribstad began her report reflecting on the meaning of Mother's Day. She reported on her activities since the last meeting, including continuing the master's in governance training and conversations with parents and community members. She made remarks about school closures and Measure R funding.

Trustee Teresa Castellanos reported that she had attended the Principal's Coffee and an assembly at Selma Olinder. She also reported on her attendance at the last District English Learner Advisory Committee (DELAC) meeting of the year and the celebration that was held to thank the parents for their commitment to improving their children's education as well as the education for English language learners in San Jose Unified.

Alternate Student Board Member Diana Loveland Lemasa gave a brief report reflecting on the excitement and stress of the end of the school year, including AP testing, upcoming senior finals, and the realization that graduation is near. She expressed appreciation for the opportunity to take AP classes and gratitude for the experience of serving as a Student Board Member. She extended congratulations and encouragement to the incoming student board members.

Trustee Carla Collins extended congratulations to the new president of the Willow Glen Education Foundation, Michelle Pilling, and shared her excitement about the foundation's future support for middle and high school students. She announced that she has continued to meet and have conversations with parents. She acknowledged the stress students experience during the process of taking AP exams and offered encouragement to them as they complete their AP exams and finals. She wished the Lincoln High School Theater Group success in their nomination for the Rita Moreno Regional Performance Awards and apologized for missing the Willow Glen "Rammys" this Thursday due to the meeting of the Advisory Committee on Use of SJPD Officers, which was scheduled to be held at the same time.

Board Vice President Brian Wheatley gave a brief report on the meetings and events in which he recently participated or attended, including the Roses Talk Project convening at Gunderson High School, the Principal's Coffee at Leland High School, and the meeting of the Coordinated School Health Collaborative. He highlighted several events, including the Falcon Family Fiesta, the May Day rally, the Lowell Festival, an SVCTE fashion pop-up, an SVCTE special meeting and the Employees of the Year celebration at Gunderson High School.

Board President José Magaña acknowledged Hoover Middle School Principal Andrew Anstead for holding a career event where students heard from a retired Warriors player and others who came to address the school. He highlighted his upcoming participation with other trustees on Saturday at the CORAL After School Program dance competition. He also acknowledged the collaborative efforts of staff, parents, and local organizations to organize, pending FIFA approval, a FIFA World Cup watch party and soccer activities for students participating in the Expanded Learning Opportunities Program (ELO-P). He announced that the CLSBA Unity Conference would be held in San José from August 27-30 and invited the Board members to submit proposals. He closed his report with an emotional tribute to Laurie (Lori) Smith, who was a family friend, mentor, and public servant who served as a Modesto planning commissioner in Ceres for more than a decade, and to her family he extended love and condolences.

O. Closed Session Report
