1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

Kirkwood Elementary School will utilize Proposition 28 Arts and Music in Schools funding to expand and enhance student access to standards-based arts education opportunities. Funding will support a part-time art teacher who will provide instruction one day per week, allowing students to engage in visual arts experiences that foster creativity, self-expression, critical thinking, and artistic skill development. In addition, Proposition 28 funds will be used to purchase art supplies and instructional materials necessary to support classroom art projects and ensure students have access to quality resources that align with California Visual and Performing Arts Standards. To further enrich the arts program, the District will provide a one-week Dance Academy for students. The Dance Academy will offer instruction in movement, choreography, performance techniques, and creative expression while promoting student engagement, collaboration, and confidence through the performing arts. These expenditures are intended to increase student access to arts education opportunities, provide hands-on artistic experiences, and support a well-rounded educational program consistent with the goals and requirements of Proposition 28.
