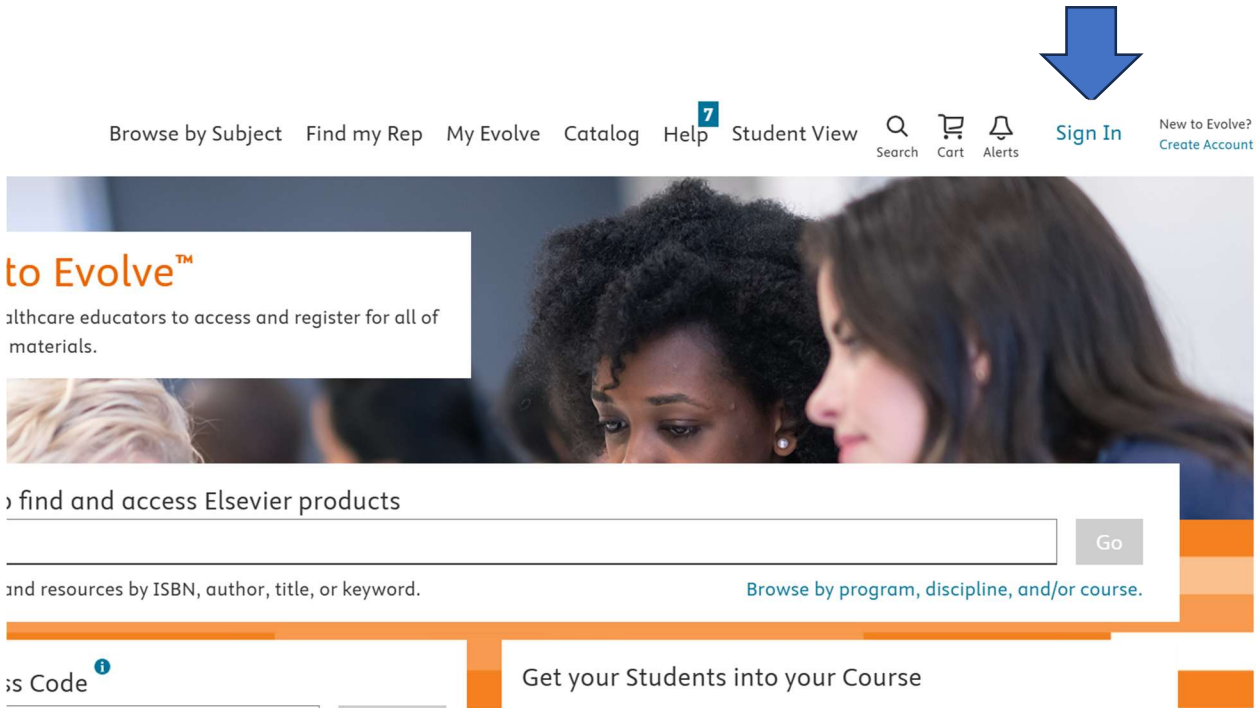
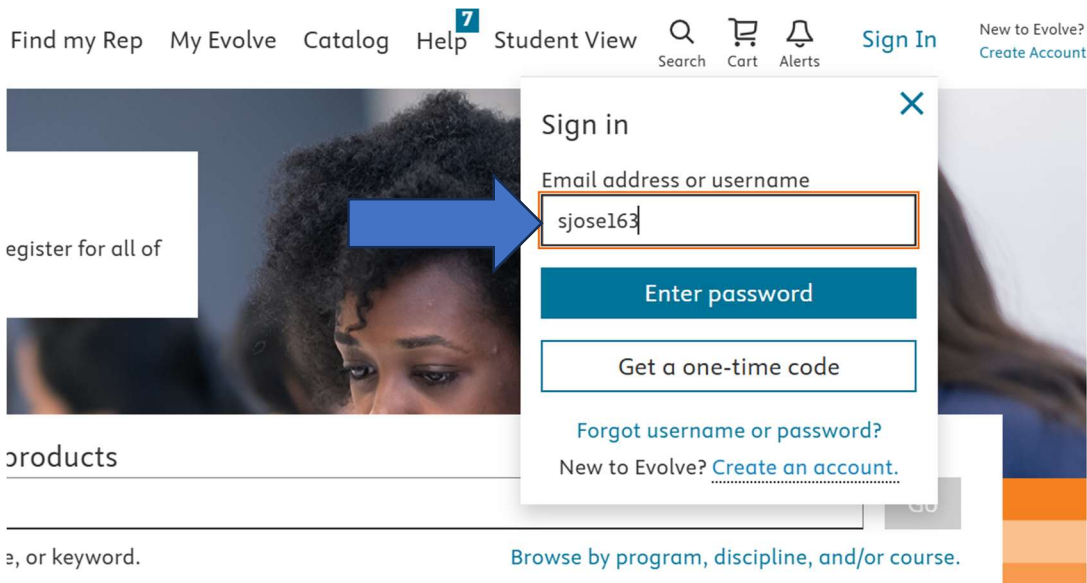


How to Access and Review Textbook and Student Resources for San Jose Parents

1. Go to the Elsevier Evolve Webpage: <https://evolve.elsevier.com/cs/store?role=faculty>
2. Click “Sign In”

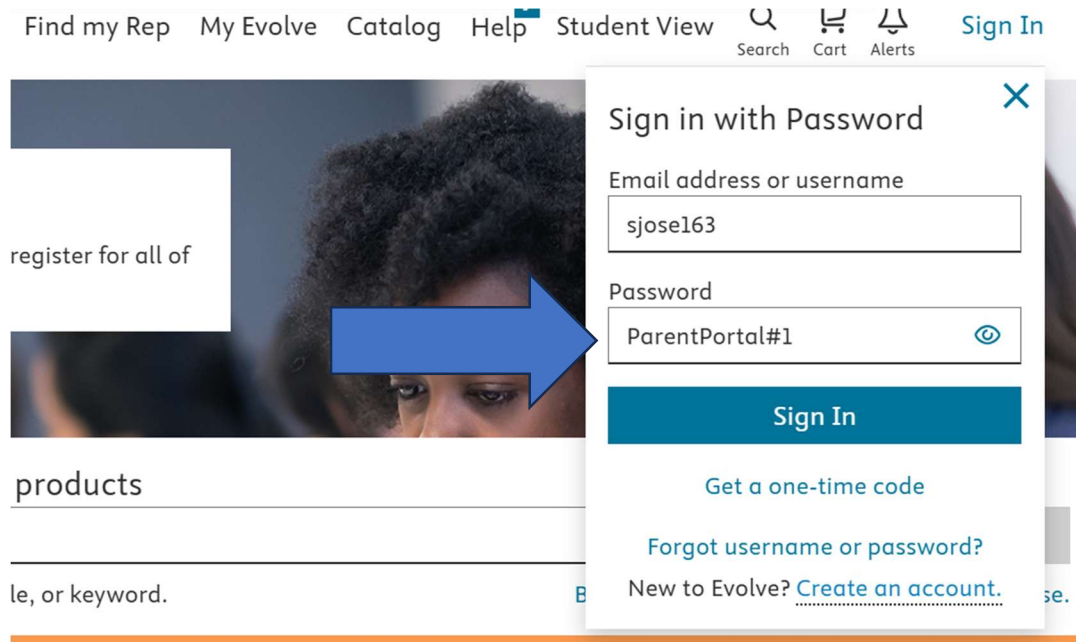


3. Enter the Username, which is **sjose163**



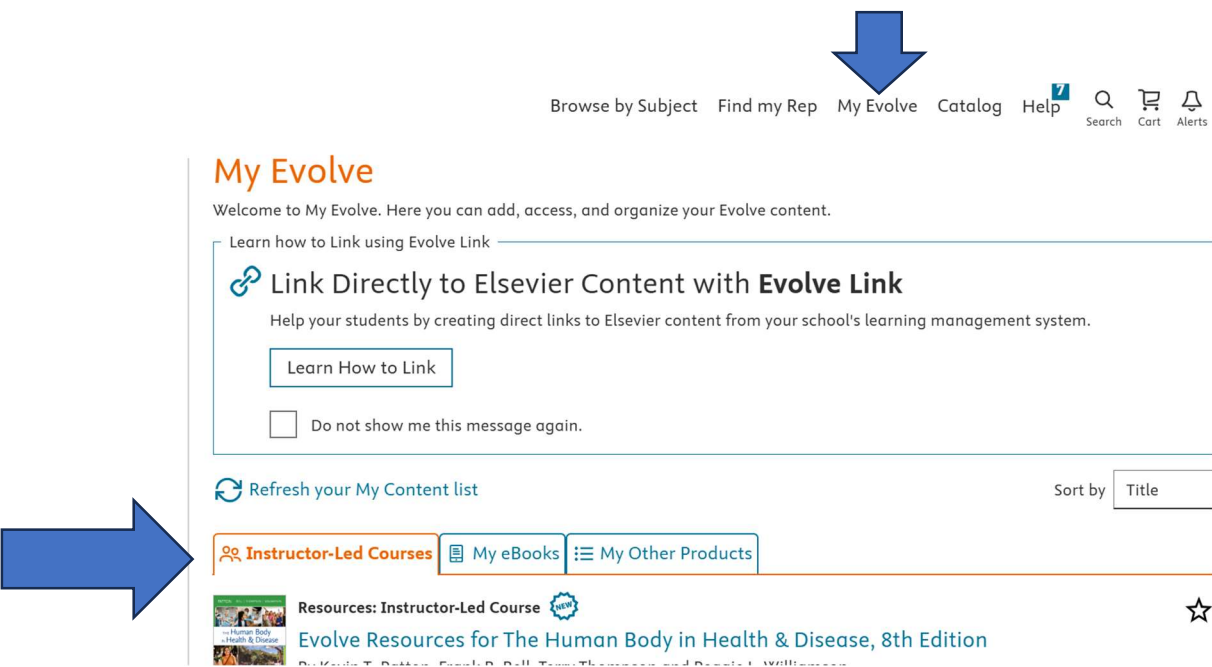
4. Click “Enter password”. **Do not click “Get a one-time code”.**

5. Enter password: **ParentPortal#1** and click “Sign In.” Password is Case Sensitive.




Get your Students into your Course

8. Under “Course Content” on the left, click on “Instructor Resources” to explore the instructor view.






10. To view the eBook, exit out of the Evolve Resources site and click on “My Evolve.” Click on the middle tab, titled “My eBooks.”

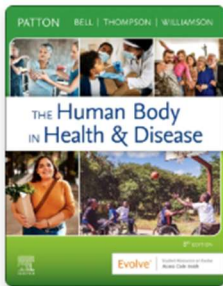
