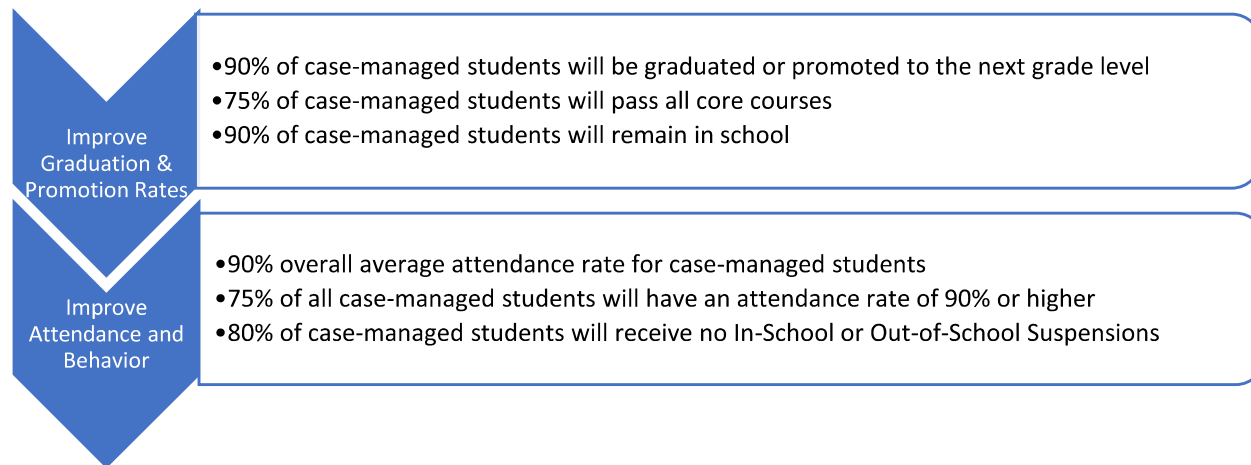


INTRODUCTION

Communities In Schools of Atlanta places a caring adult called a Site Coordinator within the school to provide small group and individualized supports targeted to address academics and college and career readiness for high school students. High school case-managed students were referred to CIS because of insufficient credits earned toward graduation and not being on track to graduate with their cohort. At Cross Keys High School, there is a focus on serving Latina/o students. CIS of Atlanta aligns with the district to provide high school students who are not on track to graduate with their cohort with targeted supports that position students for on-time graduation.

For the 2023-2024 School Year, CIS of Atlanta has the following program goals that align with the DeKalb County Program goals (see Figure 1).

Figure 1: Program Goals



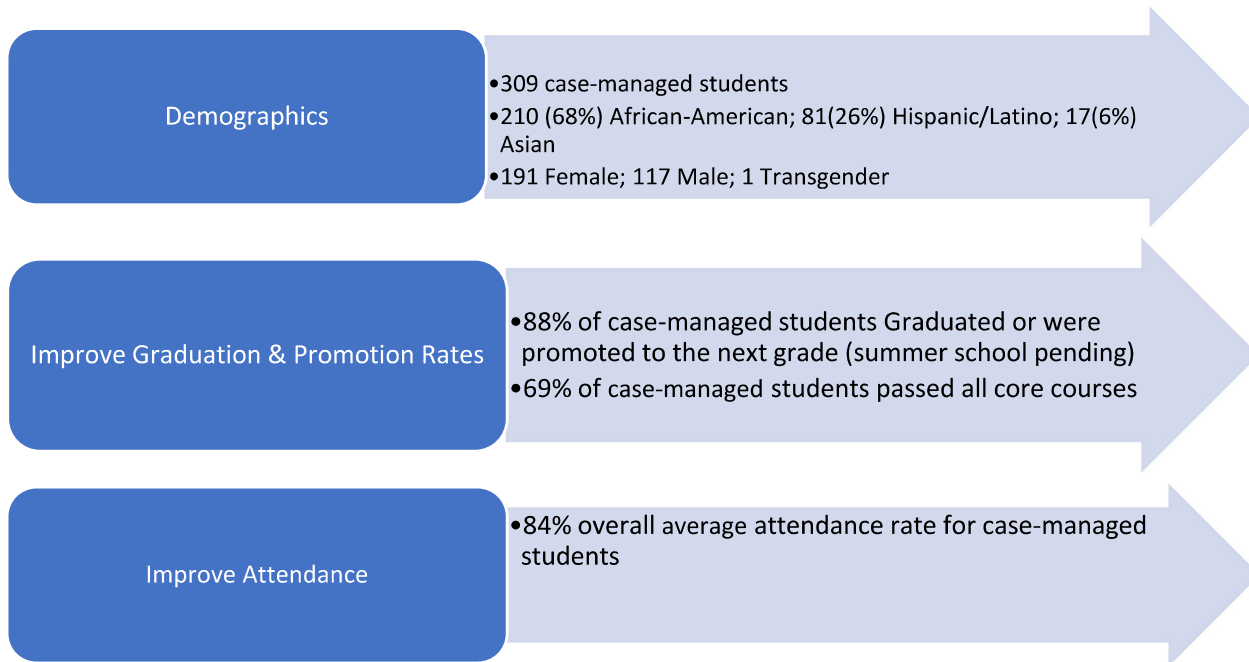
KEY FINDINGS

- 99% of students who were on caseload remained in school.
- 88% of caseload students graduated or were promoted (Pending summer school results)
- 74% of students with no suspensions
- \$31,000 of financial emergency assistance was given to families to support their basic needs
- Provided support to 309 caseload students across 5 schools.

SURROUNDING STUDENTS WITH SUPPORTS

During the 2023-2024 School Year, we served 309 case-managed students and provided student support targeting attendance, academics, case management, family engagement, and basic needs. Program goals for the year were concentrated on attendance, behavior, and core course performance. (see Figure 2)

STUDENT ENGAGEMENT

At the start of the year and end of the year, CIS conducts student engagement surveys to understand student engagement at the individual, classroom, and school levels. The survey was developed in conjunction with the American Institutes for Research, and the surveys are completed by caseload students. The survey assesses the areas of emotional, social behavioral, and cognitive engagement and is scored on a scale of 1 to 4, with 4 indicating the highest level of engagement. A global engagement score averages the total of each of the four key areas of engagement. Key findings include: *(see figure 5 below)*

- Overall, caseload students indicated high levels of student engagement
- **93.2%** of students surveyed indicated moderate or high levels of engagement across the four areas of measure.
- On a scale of 1 to 4, the average engagement score was **3.02**.

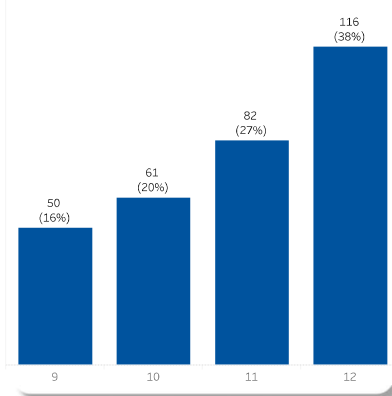

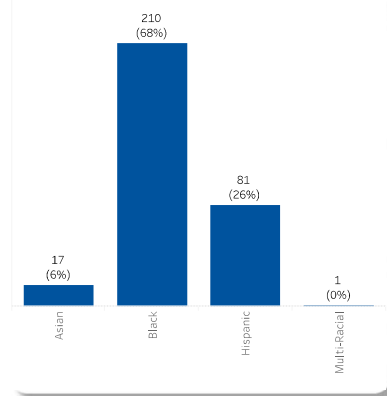

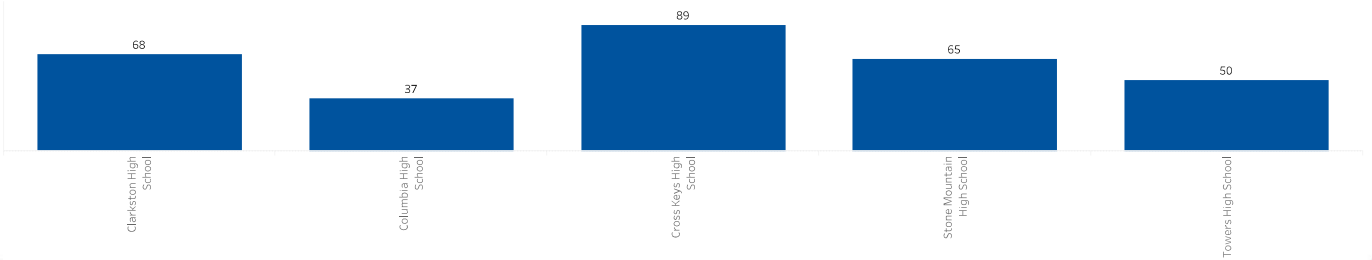
Caseload by Grade

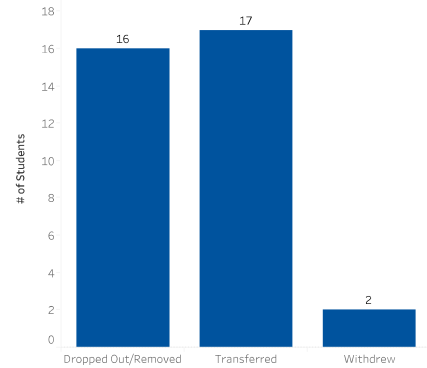
