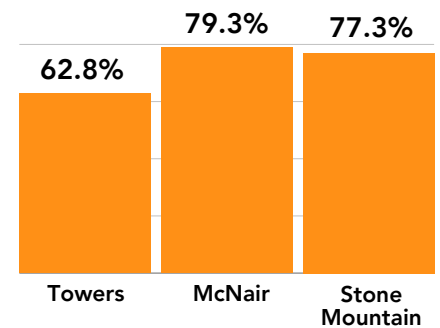

Students who have completed the 23-24 FAFSA



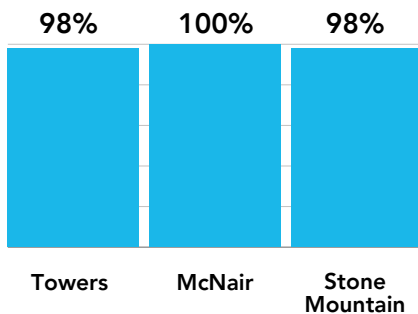
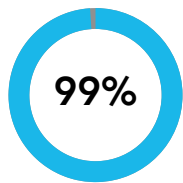

Students who created match & fit-based lists with College AIM



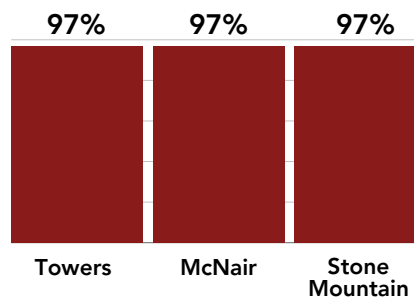
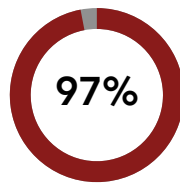

Students who have applied to college



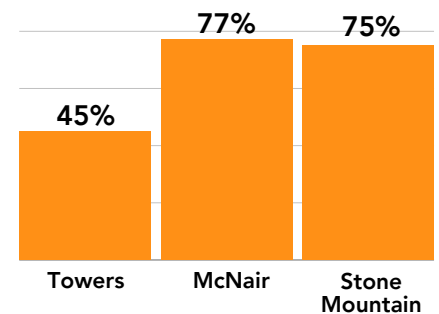
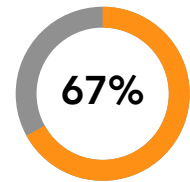

Students who have completed a financial analysis meeting



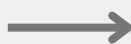

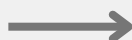
