**GRANT AWARD NOTIFICATION**

Dear Superintendent:

Attached are the FY25 CTAE grant allocations as approved by the State Board of Education on June 13, 2024. Each grant award will be loaded into the Consolidated Application (Con App) beginning July 1, 2024.

The following requirements must be met before you may spend **any** of the state or federal grant funds:

- The Local Board of Education approval date must be entered on the “Local Board Approval” tab of the Perkins V Program Improvement grant in the Consolidated Application
- The submitted budgets must be approved by GaDOE Grants Accounting.

If for any reason, your system decides it will not be able to use some or all grant funds, you should notify the GaDOE/CTAE Division **no later than September 30, 2024**, via email to [Lplan@doe.k12.ga.us](mailto:Lplan@doe.k12.ga.us).

The email should include:

- (1) the name of the grant
- (2) the amount that is being returned
- (3) the reason for returning the funds

This will allow us to recapture these funds and obtain State Board approval to redistribute funds to other systems.

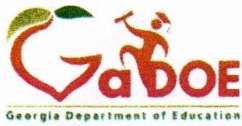
