

Chronology of the Agenda Item-
State Capital Outlay Applications

Purpose: Reimbursement of State Capital Outlay funds for eligible Dekalb County School District projects.

Reimbursement Chronology for Eligible Projects:

- In September of 2018, the Board approved the FY 2020 Capital Outlay Application, which qualified the district to receive \$2,542,752.
- In October of 2019, the Board approved the FY 2021 Capital Outlay Application, which qualified the district to receive \$8,692,880.
- In November of 2020, the Board approved the FY 2022 Capital Outlay Application, which qualified the district to receive \$8,635,420.
- In October of 2021, the Board approved the FY 2023 Capital Outlay Application, which qualified the district to receive \$2,039,031.
- In August of 2022, the Board approved the FY 2024 Capital Outlay Application, which qualified the district to receive \$16,862,594.
- In September of 2023, the Board approved the FY 2025 Capital Outlay Application, which qualified the district to receive \$52,115,602.
- If approved in September 2024, the FY 2026 Capital Outlay Application will allow the district to receive \$1,058,030.00 in Capital Outlay Funds from the Georgia Department of Education.

Projects applying for reimbursement funds in the FY 2026 Capital Outlay Project Application includes renovation, roof, and/or HVAC:

- Toney Elementary School
- Rock Chapel Elementary School
- Hightower Elementary School
