SUFFICIENCY OF TEXTBOOKS OR INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS

On motion of Board Member _____, Seconded by Board Member _____, the following resolution is adopted:

WHEREAS, in order to comply with the requirements of Education Code Section 60119, the Governing Board is required to hold a public hearing and adopt a resolution on or before the end of the eighth week of school, determining that each pupil, including English learners, has sufficient textbooks or instructional materials that are aligned with the academic content standards and consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum frameworks adopted by the State Board of Education in the following subjects: mathematics, science, history-social science, and English/language arts.

WHEREAS, as part of the required hearing, the Governing Board must also make a written determination as to whether each pupil enrolled in a foreign language or health class has sufficient textbooks or instructional materials that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum frameworks adopted by the State Board for those subjects.

WHEREAS, the Governing Board shall also determine the availability of laboratory science equipment as applicable to science laboratory courses offered in grades 9 to 12, inclusive

WHEREAS, “sufficient textbooks or instructional materials” means that each pupil, including English learners have a textbook or instructional material, or both, to use in class and to take home. This does not require two sets of textbooks or instructional materials for each pupil.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Governing Board hereby determines, as required by Education Code Section 60119, that the school district has provided each pupil, including English learners, with sufficient textbooks or instructional materials that are aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum frameworks adopted by the State Board of Education in the subjects of mathematics, science, history-social science, and English/language arts, as well as foreign language and health.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that there is available laboratory science equipment for students in science laboratory courses offered in grades 9 to 12, inclusive.
