Paradigm provides software services and school-based claiming services to local education agencies, local government agencies, school districts, County offices of education and local education consortia within the State of California for the purpose of billing Medi-Cal for special education services that have been provided by certain types of providers.		Paradigm will assist the District with all documentation required by the California Department of Health Care services to enroll service providers as Medi-Cal providers for the purposes of submitting reimbursement requests. Paradigm assists clients with establishing a provider database for effective service tracking and provides implementation training to Client program coordinators. The District has utilized Paradigm's services for many years. The previous Special Services Director considered transitioning to another vendor but ultimately found that the alternative provider's processes were more cumbersome, required additional training, and did not address all of the District's billing needs. This is a renewal of a three-year contract that was signed by the previous Director of Special Services in June of 2026, but the contract was not submitted to the Board for consideration and approval at that time. Prior Board Approval(s): June 28, 2023 (for a three-year term) Prior Board Approved Amount: Not to exceed \$200K (total amount spent each term year: 23/24FY- \$34,489.94, 24/25FY- \$63,787.48 and 25/26FY- \$75,974.97)		The District will evaluate the continued effectiveness and value of the services based on factors including service quality, ease of use, staff utilization and training requirements, responsiveness to District needs, billing functionality and accuracy, and overall operational efficiency. These factors will inform the District's determination regarding continuation, modification, or potential transition of services at the conclusion of the contract term.

Edpuzzle will provide an unlimited interactive video platform that aligns curriculum throughout the district. With Edpuzzle, teachers can share their video lessons with each other on a common platform. This feature enables educators to work efficiently and collaborate through Edpuzzle to deliver the same high-quality content. Last year, EdPuzzle introduced two new features- Quizzes and Docs that allow for progress monitoring of student performance and understanding.		The Edpuzzle resource will provide the tools necessary for teachers to continue quality content aligned lessons. Although other vendors offer similar interactive-video functionality, we recommend continuing with Edpuzzle because it is already embedded in our instructional workflow and has established adoption among teachers and students. Moving to a new provider would introduce transition, training, implementation, and content-migration costs without a sufficiently compelling difference in functionality or outcomes.
