Each school in the Dekalb County School District shall have a local school council that meets the requirements of state law and operates in an advisory capacity pursuant to appropriately adopted school council bylaws.

The role of the school council in the principal selection process shall be advisory and will be specified in regulations developed by the Superintendent.

Each school in the DeKalb County School District will have a local school council, called Principal Advisory Council, that meets state law the requirements and advises in a manner consistent with the Principal Advisory Council bylaws. of state law and operates in an advisory capacity pursuant to appropriately adopted Principal Advisory Council bylaws.

The school council's role of the school council in the principal selection process is will be advisory as specified in regulation BBFA-R (1): Local School Councils. Each charter school will have a nonprofit governing board, which fulfills the local school council requirement. and will be specified in regulations developed by the superintendent. Charter schools may choose to use an alternative to Principal Advisory Council, such as their governing boards if it complies with Georgia's requirements for local school councils.
