

Chronology of Internet Connectivity

The district is committed to supporting students who participate in remote learning. To help ensure students have equitable access to the internet beyond the classroom, 1,500 hotspots and service plans are available for students who meet eligibility requirements.

Hotspots offer reliable internet access for students in households without existing connectivity. However, availability will be limited, and the number of devices being distributed has been scaled back compared to the levels provided during the global pandemic.

Approved purchases are reimbursed through the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) for up to 90% of the cost. The district will cover the remaining 10% of all associated expenses.
