

CHRONOLOGY OF THE AGENDA ITEM
Resolution to Request GaDOE Assistance in Developing
A New Five-Year Local Facilities Plan

Scope:

Resolution requesting assistance from Georgia Department of Education for development of a new Five-Year Facilities Plan.

Background:

The DeKalb County School District ("DCSD") currently participates in the Georgia Department of Education's Capital Outlay Program.

A Five-Year Local Facilities Plan (also known as a Local Facilities Plan or Educational Facilities Construction Plan) is a strategic document that outlines a local school system's present facility conditions and projects their future needs over a five-year period. It serves as a roadmap for decision-making regarding the development, renovation, and management of educational facilities. Every five years, participating school districts must submit a Local Facilities Plan (LFP), which among other information, identifies the school and facilities to be operated by the school district at the end of the five years, along with the capital needs of the school district's facilities.

The current LFP for DCSD expires on June 30, 2026.

DCSD will be undertaking a system-wide Comprehensive Master Plan, the results of which will be available in time for the district to complete all steps necessary to get a new LFP approved by the state prior to the June 30, 2026, deadline.
