Clean Harbors Environmental Services -Hazardous and Medical Waste Disposal

Scope:

Approval of the use of Cooperative Agreement – **OMNIA Partners Contract #2023.003937 -Clean Harbors** Environmental Services. Requested scope for this item is to provide the necessary services to support the DCSD Hazmat disposal requirements.

Contract/Renewal Term:

The contract between OMNIA Partners and Clean Harbors Environmental Services is an initial five (5) year agreement from December 1, 2023, through December 1, 2028, with five (5), one (1) year optional renewals through December 1, 2033.

The Division of Operations requests approval to use the cooperative agreement, with awardee, **Clean Harbors Environmental Services** from effective date of contract execution through **June 30, 2026**, with the option to renew on an annual basis with Board of Education approval.

Solicitation Process:

On April 7, 2023, University of California (UC - Lead Procurement Agency for OMNIA) issued RFP ID -003101-Mar2023 – UC Systemwide Hazardous and Medical Waste. Clean Harbors Environmental Services is one of multiple vendors awarded a contract based on their proposal to the RFP (Request for Proposal).

Award Process

Pursuant to Board Policy DJE (Purchasing), Paragraph III -D(3)(d), Exceptions to Competitive Selection **Clean Harbors Environmental Services** was selected to provide goods and services in support of DCSD's hazmat requirements.

...” are allowed when the purchase is made through contracts formally solicited and obtained by the State of Georgia, the Federal Government, or some other government agency. The Purchasing Department shall be authorized to make purchases through inter-governmental and educational cooperative, alliances, and consortiums to achieve cost savings and administrative efficiencies based on economics of scale.”
