Dear Mr. Machado,

In accordance with State Board of Education (SBE) Policy CHTR-014, the Board of Directors of TeamCFA: Bonnie Cone Classical Academy (Bonnie Cone) is seeking SBE approval to do the following:

1. Change the name of our charter school from "TeamCFA: Bonnie Cone Classical Academy" to "Bonnie Cone Classical Academy";
2. Terminate Bonnie Cone's CMO Agreement with TeamCFA; and
3. Employ Charter One as Bonnie Cone's Educational Management Organization (EMO).

TeamCFA and the Board of Directors for Bonnie Cone have mutually agreed to terminate our CMO agreement. We have selected Charter One as the proposed EMO moving forward. The proposed Services Agreement is attached as Attachment 1. With the assistance of TeamCFA and Charter One, the Board has reached a resolution which all parties believe to be the best outcome for the school. Upon approval of this request, the school will be managed by Charter One under the direction of the Board of Directors bearing the name of Bonnie Cone Classical Academy.


We chose Charter One after careful consideration and for several reasons. First, our education plan remains unchanged from the plan approved in our charter application. Charter One's experience with Core Knowledge Sequence, Core Knowledge Language Arts, and Singapore Math supports and enhances our education plan. Second, we believe that Charter One is uniquely qualified to assist us in the management of our school. Charter One has a network of 11 schools across Arizona, Nevada, and Florida. It is also the EMO for the newly approved charter school, Wake Preparatory Academy.

We are confident that our partnership with Charter One will be a long-term partnership that will benefit our scholars, staff, and community. The attached proposed contract has been developed after careful consideration and discussion between both parties. The contract is fair to both parties and makes clear that the Board of Directors is responsible for the school and will hold Charter One accountable for results. The contract also allows the school to benefit from their considerable experience in opening and supporting the operation of charter schools and their commitment to provide a high-quality education for our students. Attachment 2 provides a copy of the board meeting minutes where we approved seeking SBE approval to terminate our agreement with TeamCFA and enter into a contract with Charter One as our EMO.

We appreciate your consideration and look forward to your prompt approval of our request.


