3	7-2	7 th graders will explore at least three (3) Career Clusters based on their career inventory results. (<i>If using YouScience for this task, YouScience Snapshot must be taken first.</i>)	GaDOE
4	8-2	8 th graders will use their career interest and career aptitude inventory results to complete an Individual College and Career Plan in consultation with parent(s)/legal guardian(s) to guide registration for high school courses.	GaDOE
5	8-3	8 th graders will receive notification of the Georgia Dual Enrollment program information by February 1st .	GaDOE

2	9-2	Students will create and utilize a GAfutures account through gafutures.org .	GSFC
3	9-3	9 th graders will explore at least three (3) Careers / Occupations and save the results in their electronic career profile. (<i>If using YouScience, students may use Snapshot results for this task. If they do not have Snapshot results, students may take Summit and then complete the task.</i>)	GaDOE
4	9-4	9 th graders will review and revise their Individual College and Career Plan in consultation with parent(s)/legal guardian(s) to guide course registration and ensure post-secondary success.	GaDOE
5	9-5	9 th graders will receive notification of the Georgia Dual Enrollment program information by February 1st .	GaDOE
6	10-2	10 th graders will review and revise their Individual College and Career Plan in consultation with parent(s)/legal guardian(s) to guide course registration and ensure post-secondary success.	GaDOE
7	10-3	10 th graders will receive notification of the Georgia Dual Enrollment program information by February 1st .	GaDOE
8	11-1	11 th graders will save three possible choices of post-secondary options.	GaDOE
9	11-2	11 th graders will review and revise their Individual College and Career Plan in consultation with parent(s)/legal guardian(s) to guide course registration and ensure post-secondary success.	GaDOE

14	12-2	12 th graders will complete "Next Step" information and save to their electronic career portfolio: 4-year institution, 2-year institution, apprenticeship, military, technical college, special purpose (vocational) school or workforce.	GaDOE
