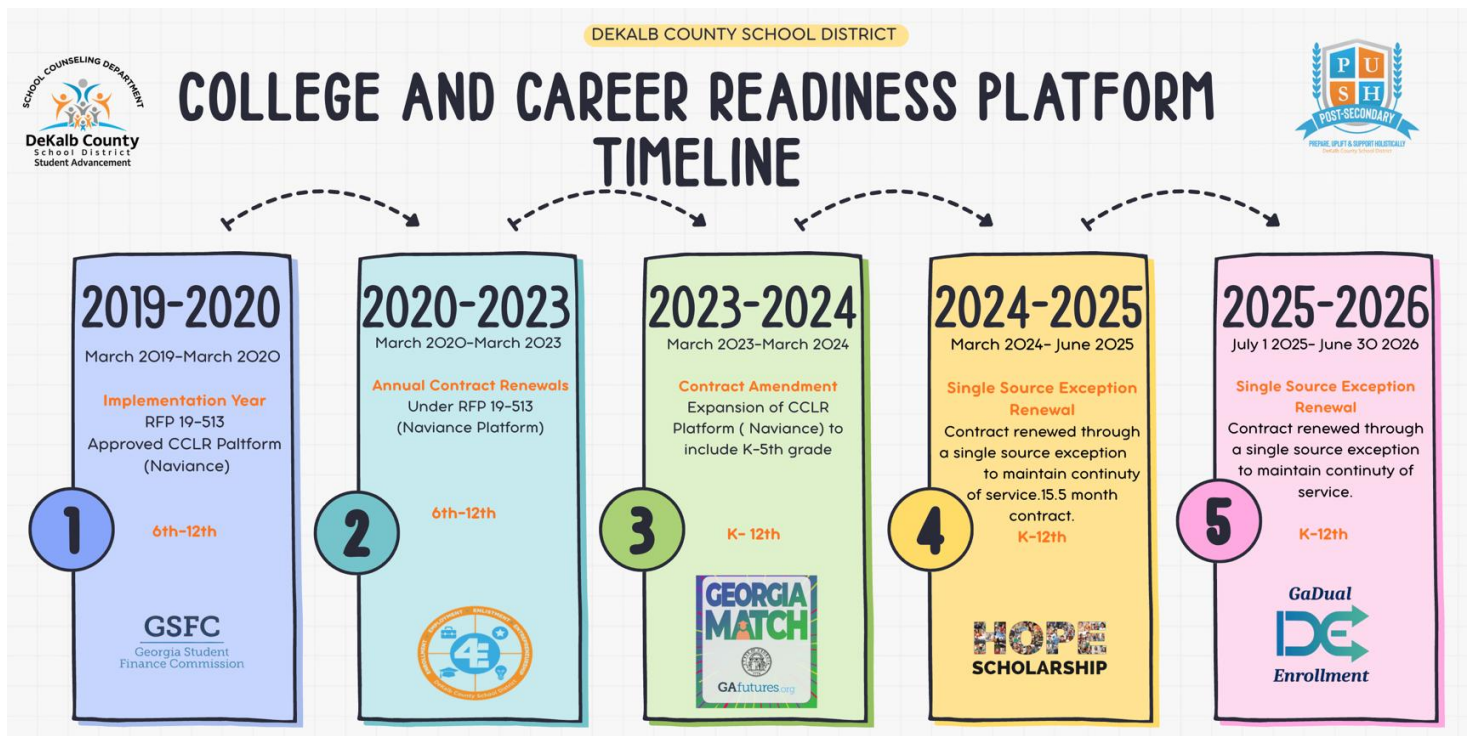


Chronology

Item: College and Career Readiness Platform in DeKalb County School District

On January 9, 2019, the DeKalb County School District Board of Education approved the district's first College and Career Readiness (CCLR) platform, Naviance, to support student postsecondary planning and career exploration. The platform provides tools for career assessments, college matching, scholarship searches, goal setting, and work-based learning tracking while allowing students—particularly juniors and seniors—to apply to colleges, request official transcripts, and access scholarship opportunities. DCSD is transitioning to **SchoolLinks** as its centralized college, career, and life readiness platform to expand these services and improve alignment with Georgia Department of Education requirements. **SchoolLinks** will also streamline state reporting by providing the only GADOE-approved integrated Work-Based Learning management system that automatically submits required data through the official reporting portal.
