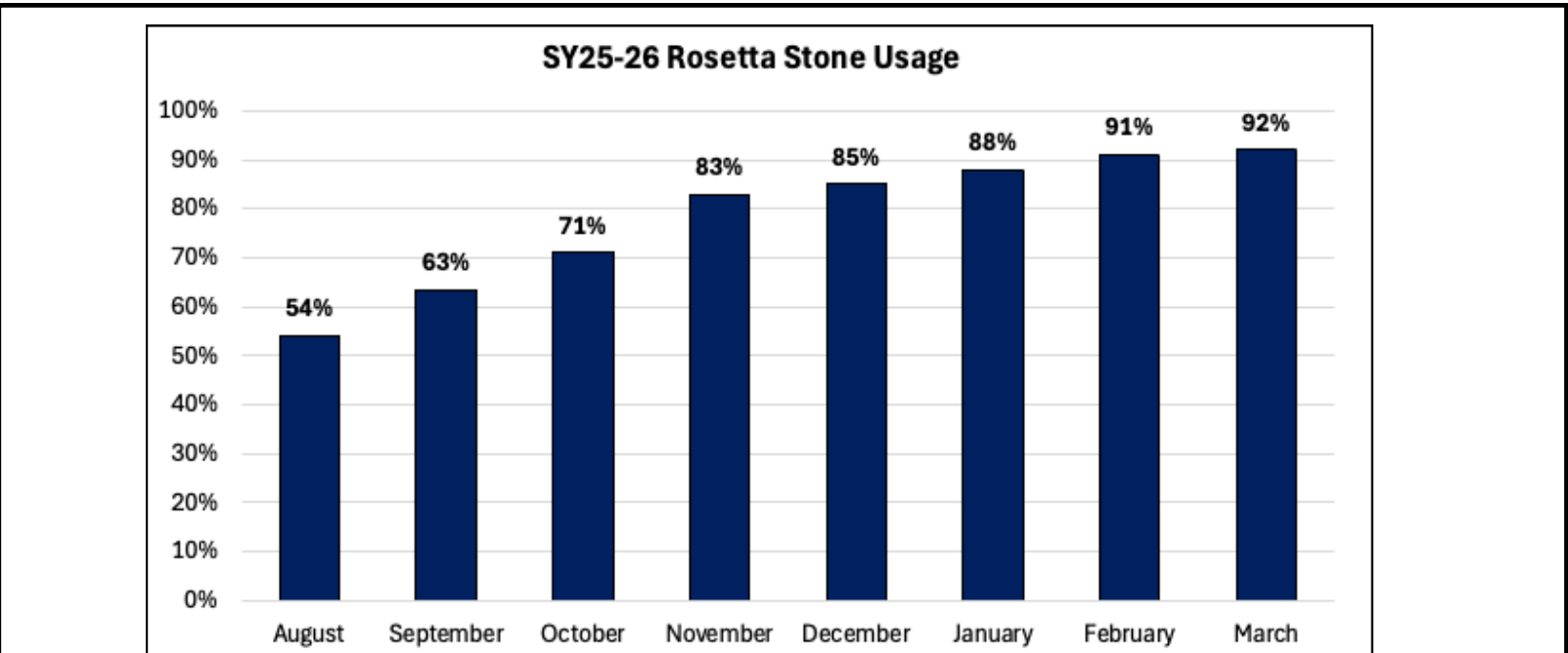
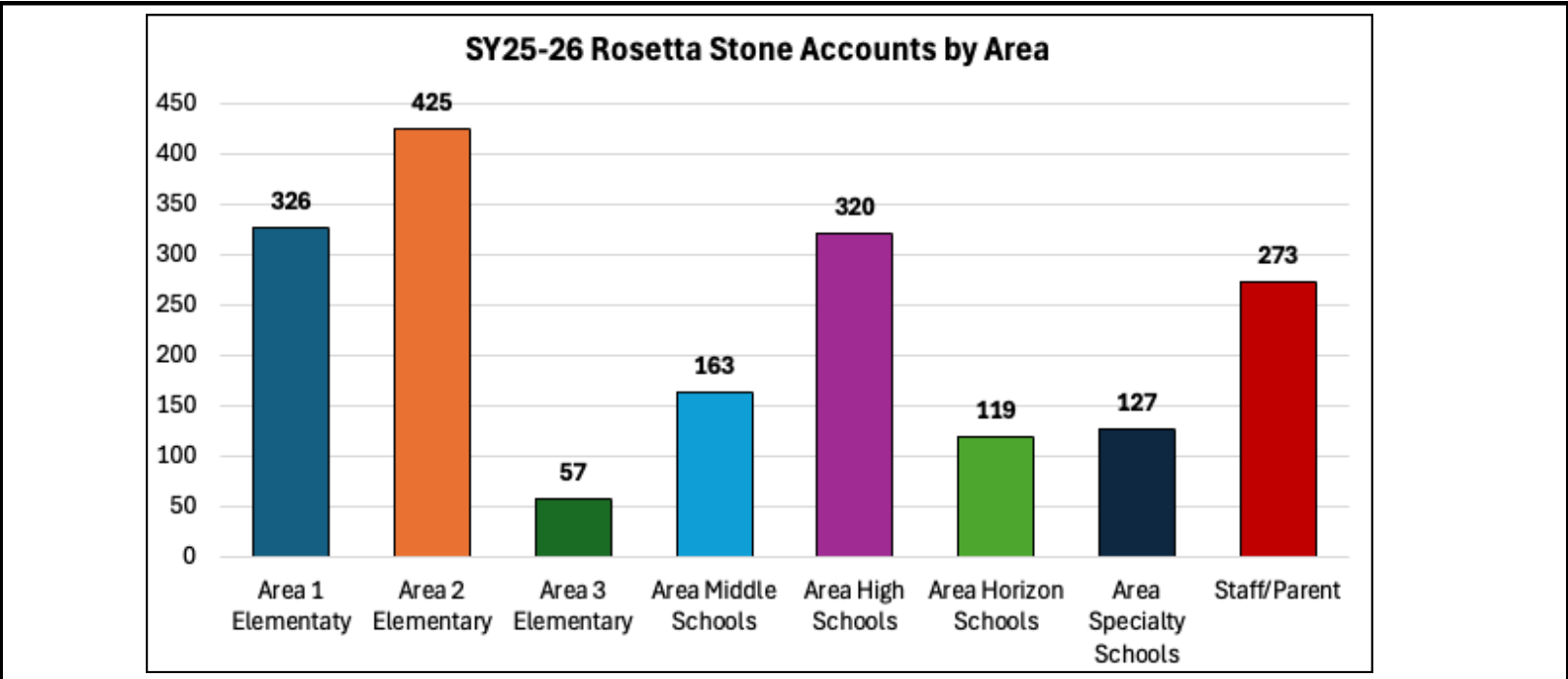




Rosetta Stone Overview and Data Usage

Rosetta Stone is a supplemental resource that provides intensive language support for newcomer English language learners (ELLs) in grades 3-12. Rosetta Stone is an immersive language program that provides realistic situations and scenarios for students to practice using English in all four language domains: speaking, reading, writing, and listening. Teachers can assign differentiated practice and assignments within the Rosetta Stone platform to enhance student learning outside of content and language instruction.

Rosetta Stone accounts are also available to support parent and DCSD staff language acquisition. DCSD staff can utilize Rosetta Stone to learn languages that enhance their cultural and linguistic understanding with the diverse student population and communities within DeKalb County. Parents and families of DCSD students can access Rosetta Stone accounts to assist with their English language acquisition, facilitating a smoother transition for supporting their DCSD students and navigating in the community.
