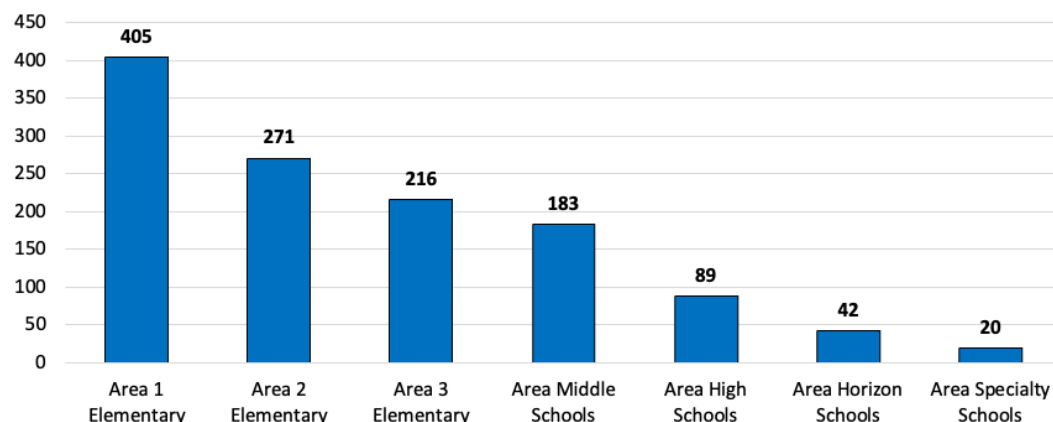


Lexia® Lexia Core5, PowerUp, Lexia English Overview and Data Usage

Lexia provides three reading and language programs used to provide targeted support for English learners at all proficiency levels. Core5 is a literacy program designed to support students in grades K-8 through six key areas: phonological awareness, phonics, vocabulary, structural analysis, automaticity and fluency, and comprehension. PowerUp supports students from grades 6-12, focusing on word study, grammar, and comprehension, with a strong emphasis on academic language. Core5 and PowerUp are used with students in the general ESOL program who have language proficiency levels from an emerging 2.0 CPL on the WIDA ACCESS for ELLs assessment. Lexia English is explicitly designed to support newcomers with beginning language proficiency. One key benefit of Lexia English is its emphasis on speaking and listening, which are essential for developing foundational language skills among newcomers. For SY26-27, the English Learners department will target schools with high ELL populations and Horizon schools with professional learning to improve teachers' utilization of the platform, leading to improved outcomes for their ELLs.
