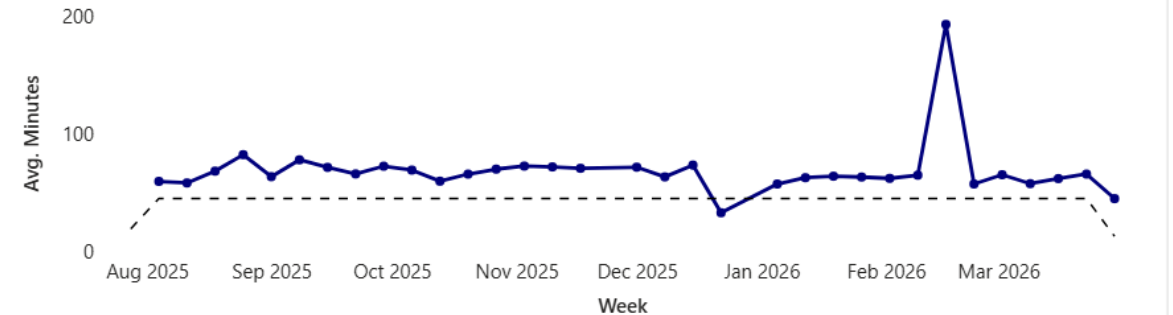
Usage Overview 3rd-8th

- Usage is highest in 3rd-5th grade

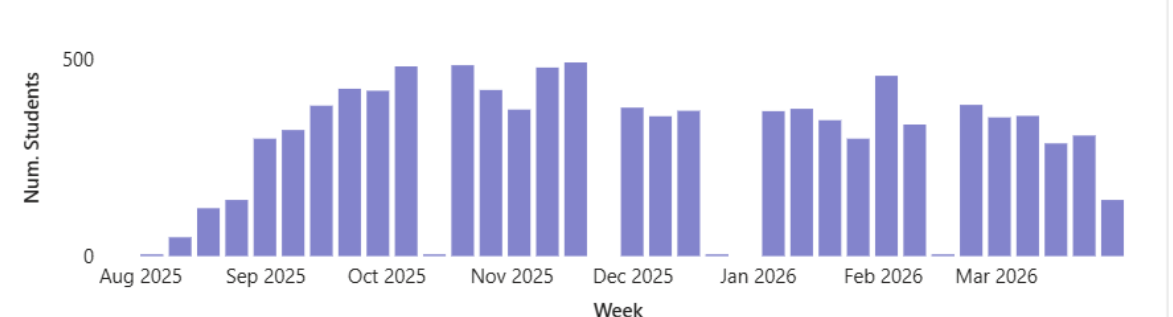

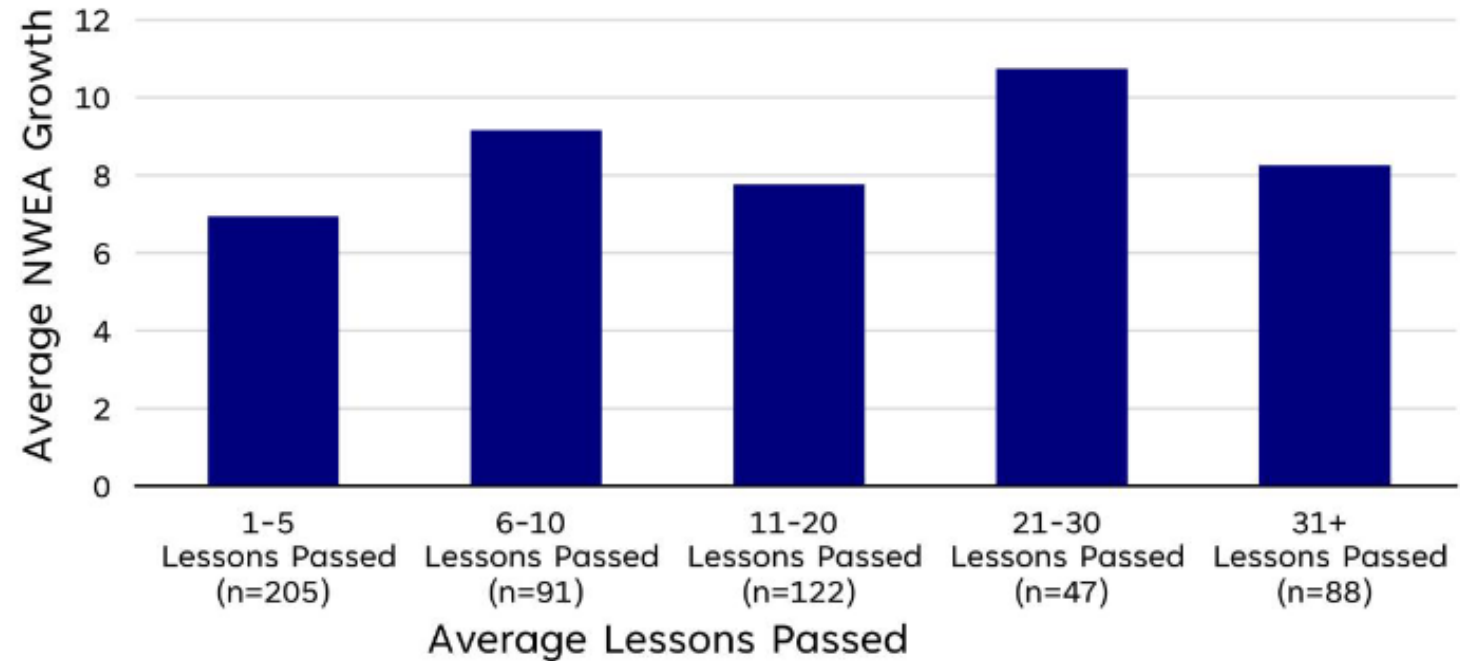

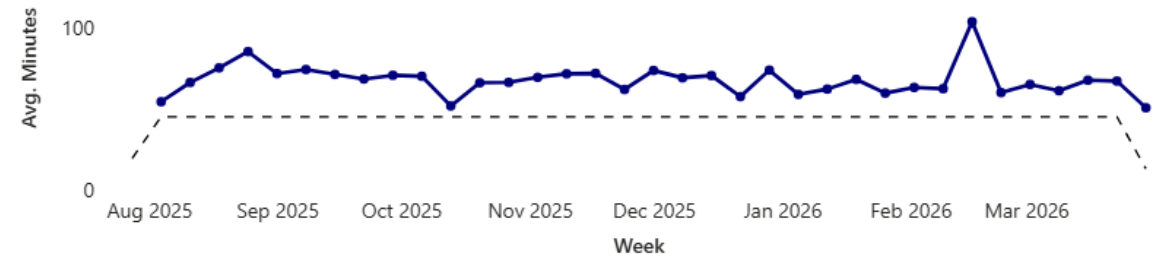
Usage Overview

- Gaps in student usage align with holiday breaks

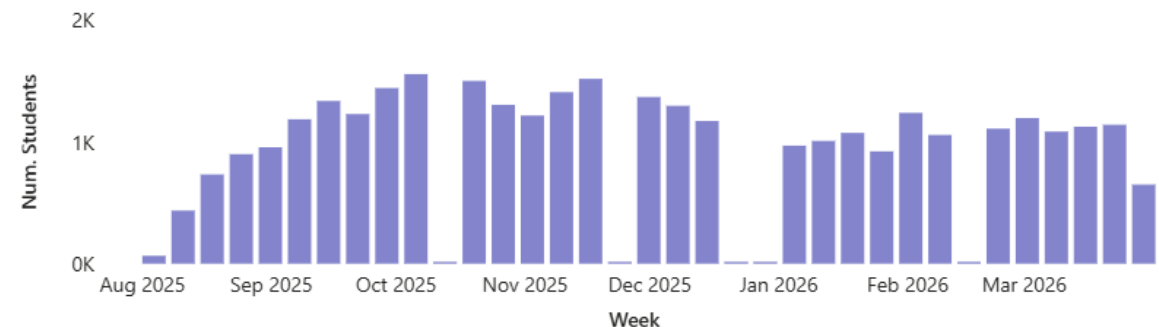

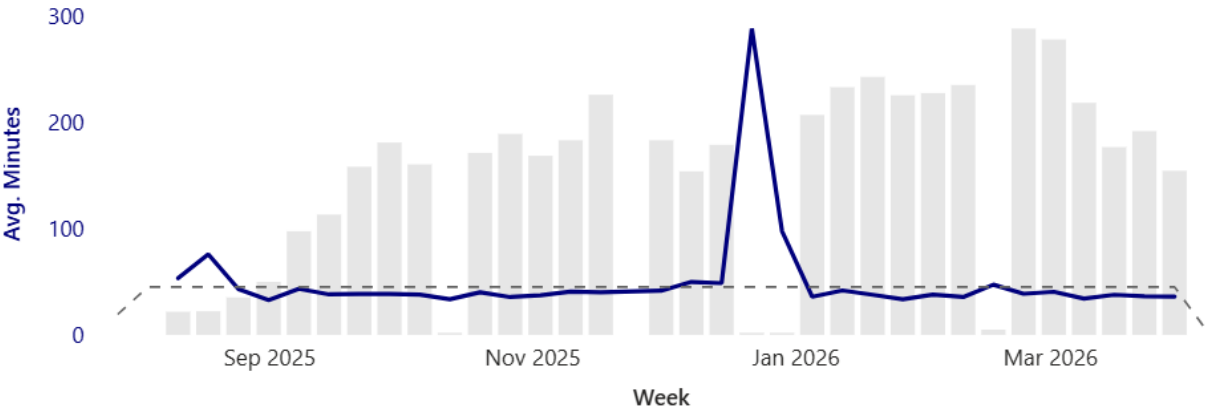

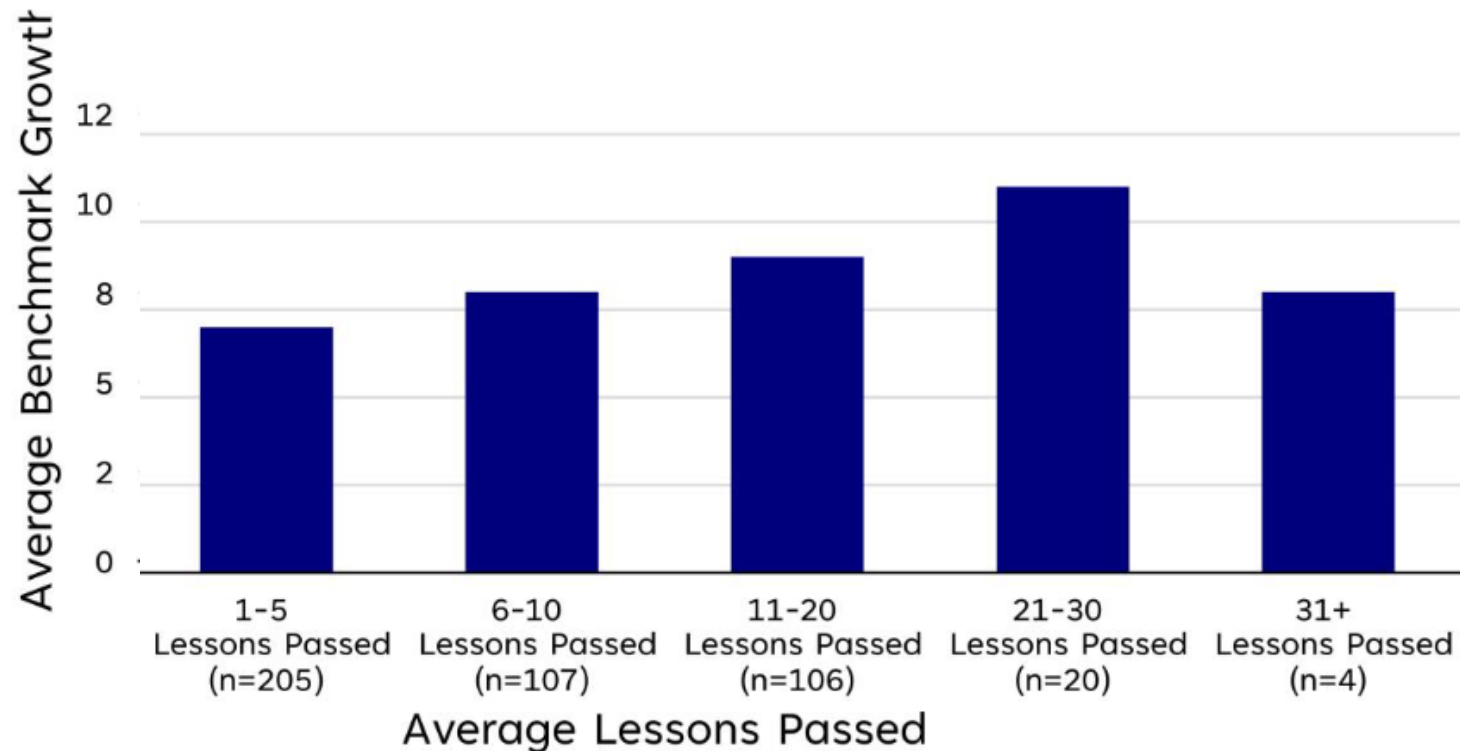
