Agreement to Furnish Food Service for the DeKalb Parks and Recreation After School Snacks

This agreement is made and entered into between DeKalb County School Nutrition Services and DeKalb Parks and Recreation. WHEREAS the DeKalb County School Nutrition Services agrees to provide daily unitized after school snacks to nine DeKalb Parks and Recreation Programs.

DeKalb Parks and Recreation is solely responsible for serving after school snacks provided by DeKalb County School Nutrition Services and shall maintain HACCP Procedures. DeKalb County School Nutrition Services will provide after school snacks effective August 4, 2025 through May 28, 2026. School Nutrition Services will not provide meals if schools are closed for inclement weather. 8-26-5-27
