

2026 Chronology: Blue Mantis HPE GreenLake Infrastructure and Managed Services Renewal (Year 3)

DeKalb County School District utilizes HPE GreenLake infrastructure at the William Bradley Bryant Center (WBBC), which serves as the District's primary data center. This environment provides the technology foundation that supports many of the District's instructional, business, and operational systems.

For the 2026-27 school year, the Division of Information and Instructional Technology (DIIT) is requesting approval to continue both the HPE GreenLake infrastructure platform and the managed services required to operate and support that environment.

HPE GreenLake Infrastructure Platform- Cost: \$408,840.00

The HPE GreenLake infrastructure platform provides the computing and storage resources that support many of the District's critical technology systems.

Key Services Provided:

- Enterprise computing infrastructure that supports District applications and services
- Enterprise data storage used by instructional, business, and operational systems
- Secure storage and protection of District data
- Infrastructure capacity to support current and future technology needs
- Technology resources hosted within the District's primary data center at WBBC
- Reliable platform services that support daily operations across schools and departments

Blue Mantis Managed Services- Cost: \$91,871.76

Blue Mantis provides ongoing management, monitoring, maintenance, and technical support services for the HPE GreenLake environment.

Key Services Provided:

- Ongoing monitoring of system performance, health, and reliability
- Proactive management and administration of the GreenLake environment
- Technical support and troubleshooting assistance
- Issue identification and resolution to help minimize service disruptions
- Routine maintenance and system updates
- Performance reviews and optimization activities
- Capacity planning and operational support
- Assistance with service requests and infrastructure-related issues

These services provide the technology environment that supports daily operations across the District, including instructional applications, business systems, communications, data storage, and other essential services. Continued support through Blue Mantis will help ensure reliable system performance, minimize downtime, and provide the ongoing infrastructure and support necessary to meet the District's operational needs.

Procurement:

In accordance with Board of Education Purchasing Policy DJE III.D.3.d., the Purchasing Department shall be authorized to make purchases through inter-governmental and educational cooperatives, alliances, and consortiums to achieve cost savings and administrative efficiencies based on economies of scale. Therefore, this purchase will utilize The Interlocal Purchasing System (TIPS) Contract 230504.
