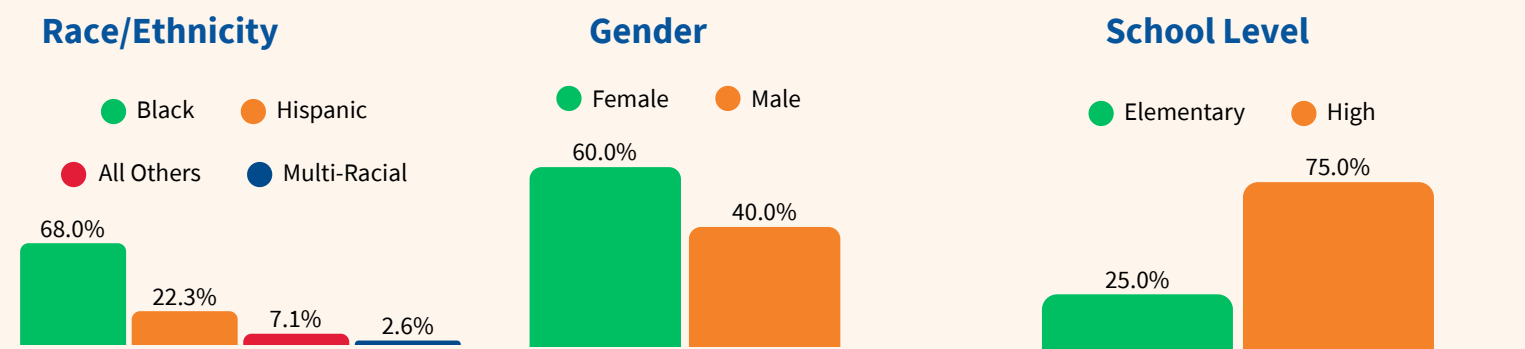


2025-2026 Impact Overview

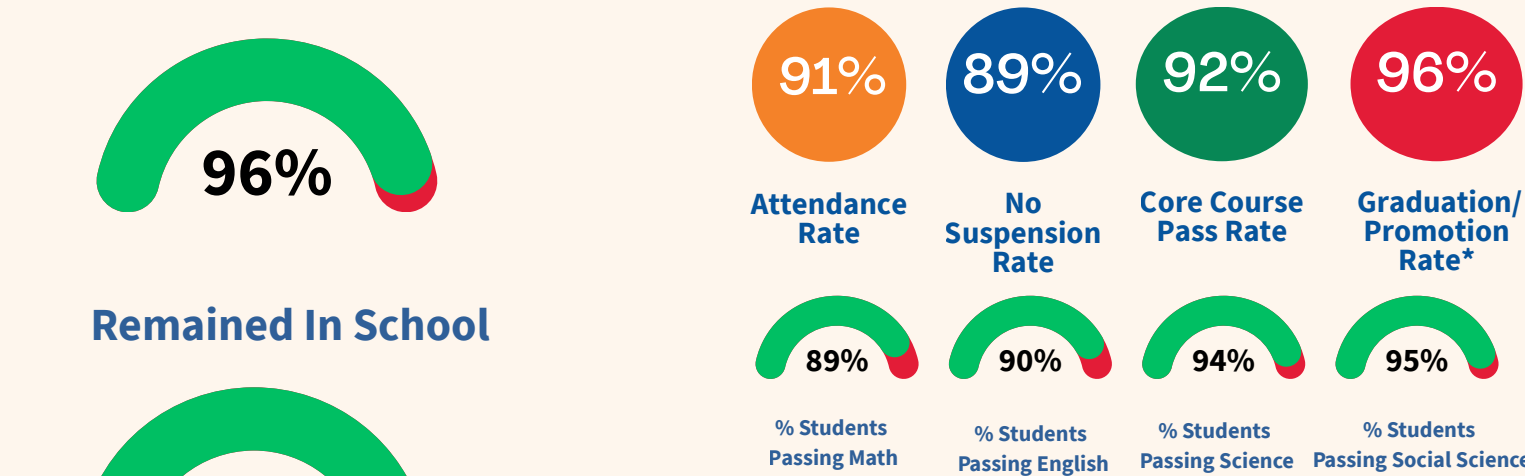


Dekalb '25-'26 Demographics

Helping Kids Stay in School and Achieve in Life

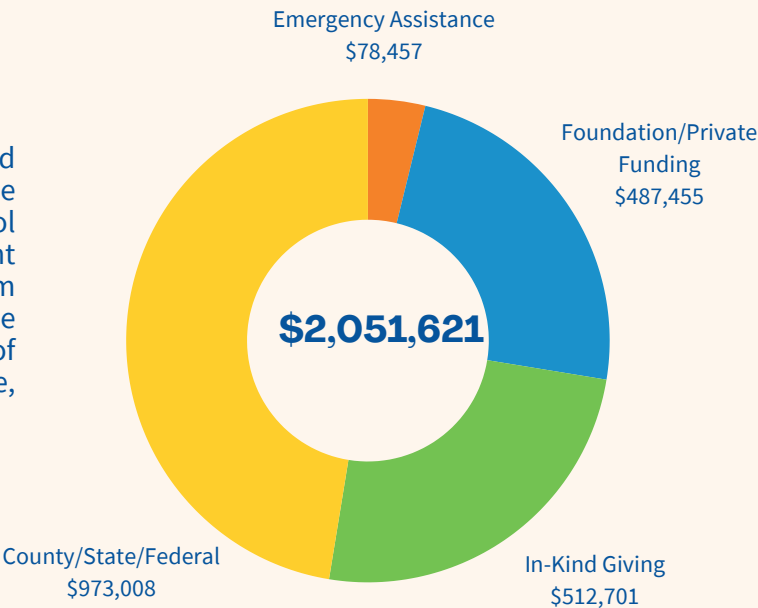
Four-Year Impact Overview



Each day many Metro Atlanta students face enormous barriers to their success in school and in life. Atlanta has the nation’s highest poverty and income inequality rates, which create unfair obstacles contributing to chronic absenteeism, making it hard for them to participate equally in academic and enrichment programs, and increasing their chances of dropping out. Communities In Schools of Atlanta places caring adults inside schools to create a consistent, day-after-day academic, emotional and financial support system to help kids stay in school and graduate.

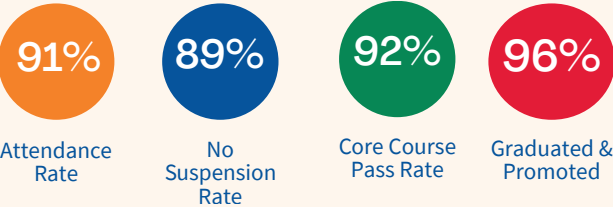
Economic Impact

CIS of Atlanta is proud to work with private, foundation, and community partners to secure additional investment for the benefit of our programming within Dekalb County School District. This helps to leverage the programming investment from DCSD by bringing in additional resources from community partners and investors. Over the prior 4 years, we have secured over \$2.05 million in funding from a variety of partners. For every dollar invested by DCSD over this time, CIS of Atlanta has returned \$1.57 in equivalent resources.

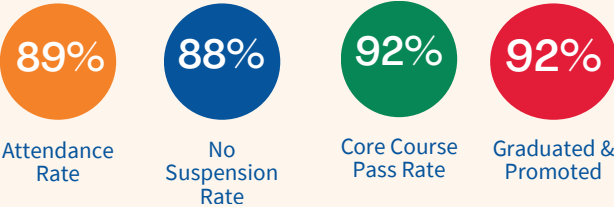

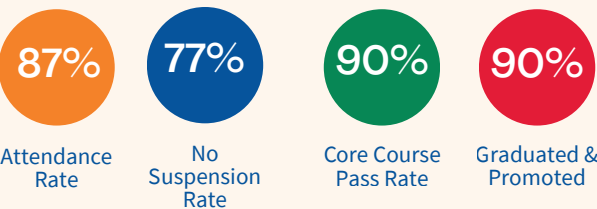

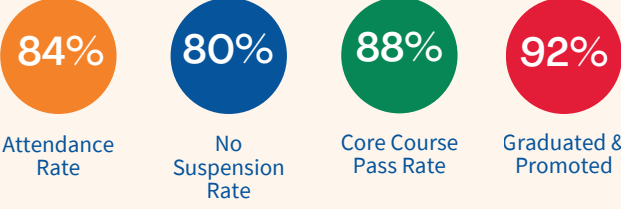

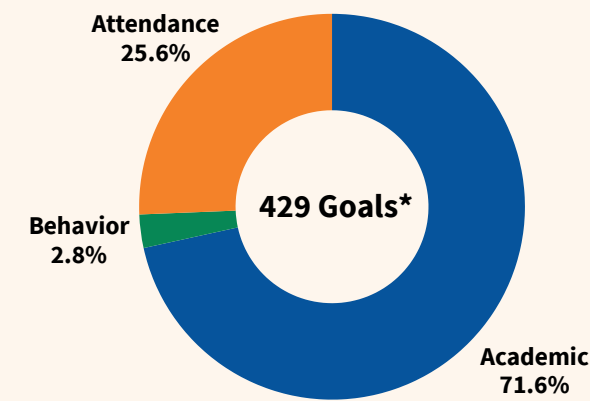

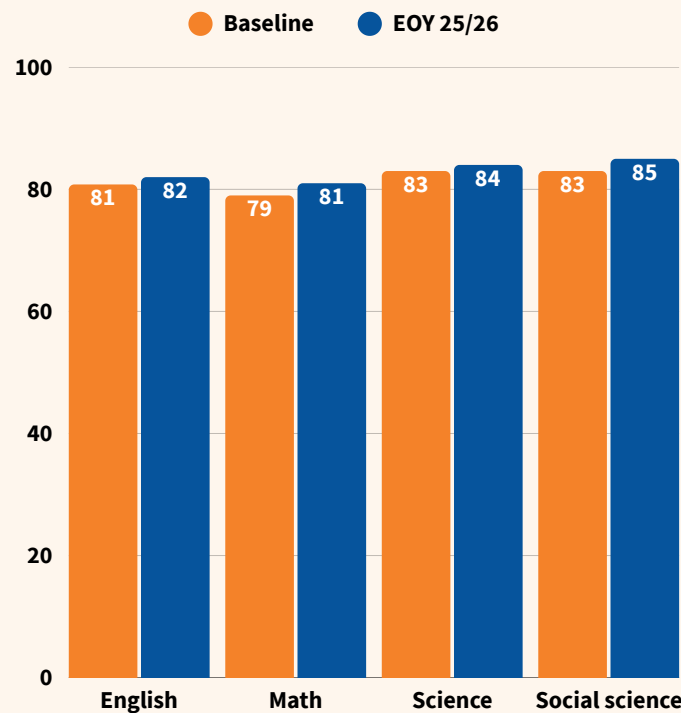


Student Goal Overview



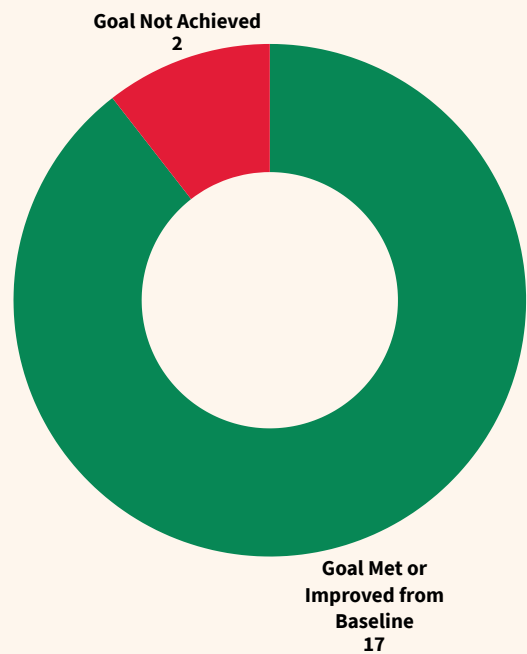

Core Course Progress from Baseline

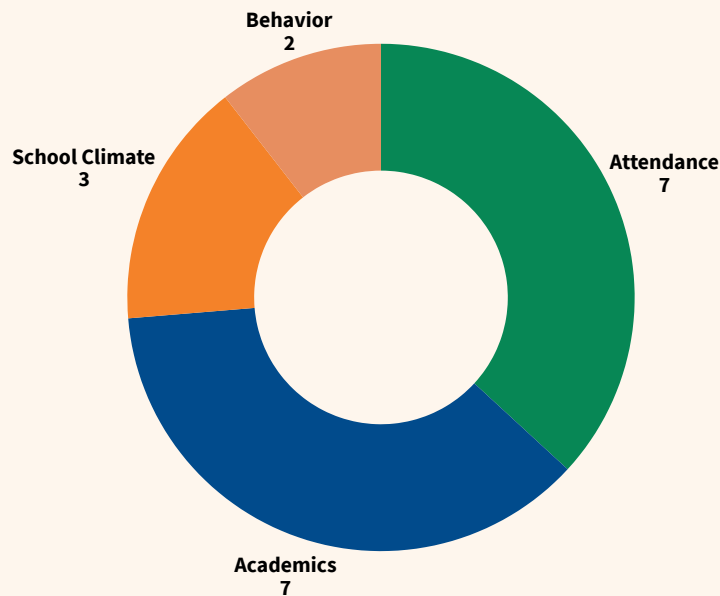

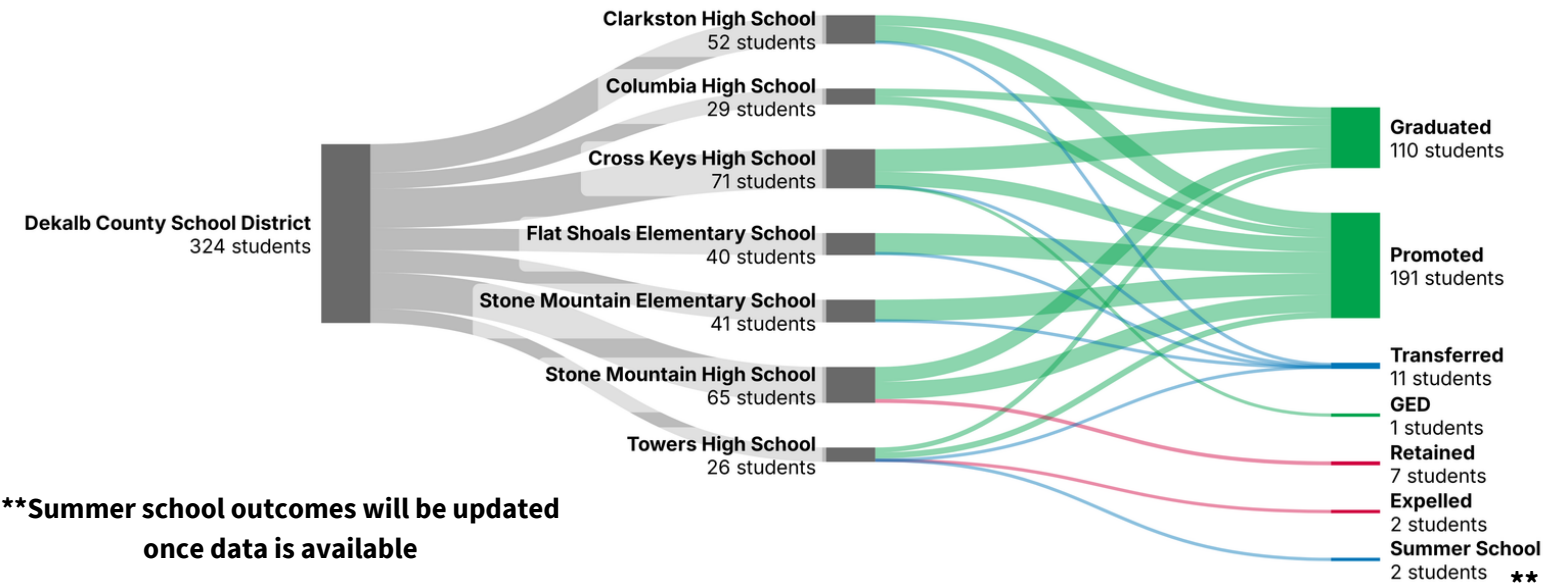

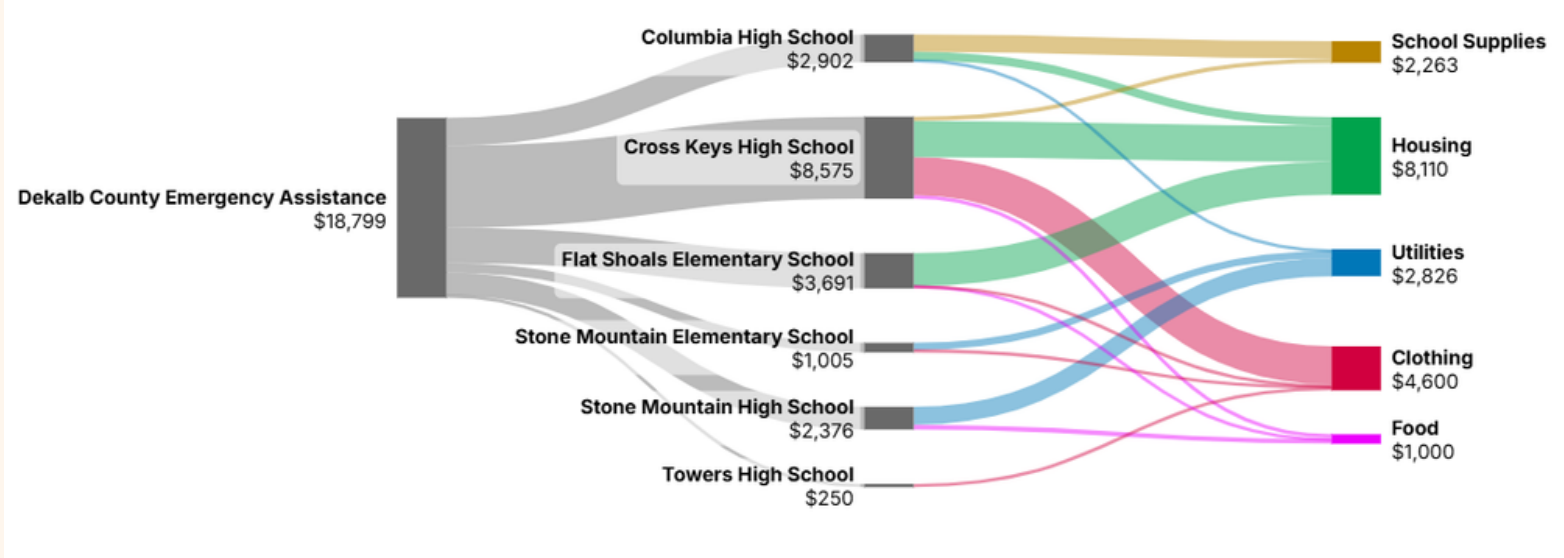

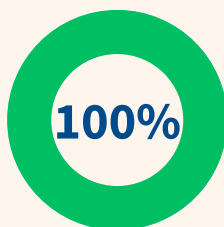

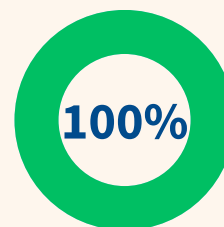
