Communities In Schools of Atlanta, Inc.
August 2026

2018 – 2019 School Year

Communities In Schools of Atlanta, Inc. provided integrated student support services to Towers High School and Cross Keys High School in the amount of \$63,000.

2019 – 2020 School Year

Communities In Schools of Atlanta, Inc. provided integrated student support services to Towers High School, Cross Keys High School, Columbia High School, and Stone Mountain High School in the amount of \$180,000.

2020 – 2021 School Year

Communities In Schools of Atlanta, Inc. continued providing integrated student support services to Towers High School, Cross Keys High School, Columbia High School, and Stone Mountain High School in the amount of \$180,000.

July 2022

The DeKalb County Board of Education approved a Letter of Agreement with Communities In Schools of Atlanta, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$325,000, to implement the evidence-based Communities In Schools model and provide integrated student support services and case management throughout the district. Services were provided to Clarkston High School, Columbia High School, Cross Keys High School, Stone Mountain High School, and Towers High School.

August 2023

On August 14, 2023, the DeKalb County Board of Education approved the annual Letter of Agreement with Communities In Schools of Atlanta, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$325,000. The agreement continued integrated student support services aligned with the district's priorities for student engagement, academic success, attendance, and social-emotional well-being. Services were provided to Clarkston High School, Columbia High School, Cross Keys High School, Stone Mountain High School, and Towers High School.

July 2024

On July 8, 2024, the DeKalb County Board of Education approved the annual Letter of Agreement with Communities In Schools of Atlanta, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$325,000. The agreement supported the continued implementation of integrated student support services based on sustained program performance, measurable student outcomes, and continued alignment with the district's strategic priorities. Services were provided to Clarkston High School, Columbia High School, Cross Keys High School, Stone Mountain High School, and Towers High School.

August 2025

On August 25, 2025, the DeKalb County Board of Education approved a one-year Letter of Agreement with Communities In Schools of Atlanta, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$325,000, extending services through June 30, 2026. Services continued at Clarkston High School, Columbia High School, Cross Keys High School, Stone Mountain High School, and Towers High School.

August 2026

For the August 2026 Board meeting, approval is requested for a Memorandum of Agreement with Communities In Schools of Atlanta, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$500,000. The agreement will continue integrated student support services at Clarkston High School, Columbia High School, Cross Keys High School, Stone Mountain High School, and Towers High School, while expanding services to Columbia Middle School, McNair Middle School, and Stone Mountain Middle School. This expansion reflects the district's commitment to increasing equitable access to comprehensive student support for schools with the greatest identified needs.
