Speaker Moore's Statement on the Passing of Linda Johnson

Senior House Appropriations Chairwoman and Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee Co-Chairwoman

Kings Mountain, N.C. – North Carolina House Speaker Tim Moore (R-Cleveland) released a statement Tuesday on the passing of Senior House Appropriations Committee Chairwoman Linda Johnson (R-Cabarrus).

“Linda Johnson had a beloved and infectious spirit that resonated throughout the North Carolina General Assembly every day, and the tragic news of her passing is a terrible loss for our legislative community, her family, and the people she served in Cabarrus County,” Speaker Moore said Tuesday. ***“I know I speak for all my colleagues that she represented the very best of North Carolina and will always be remembered for her kind nature and powerful voice for public schools.”***

Rep. Linda Johnson served 10 terms in the North Carolina House of Representatives representing Cabarrus County in state House District 82.

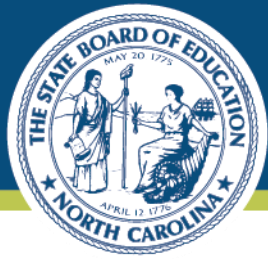

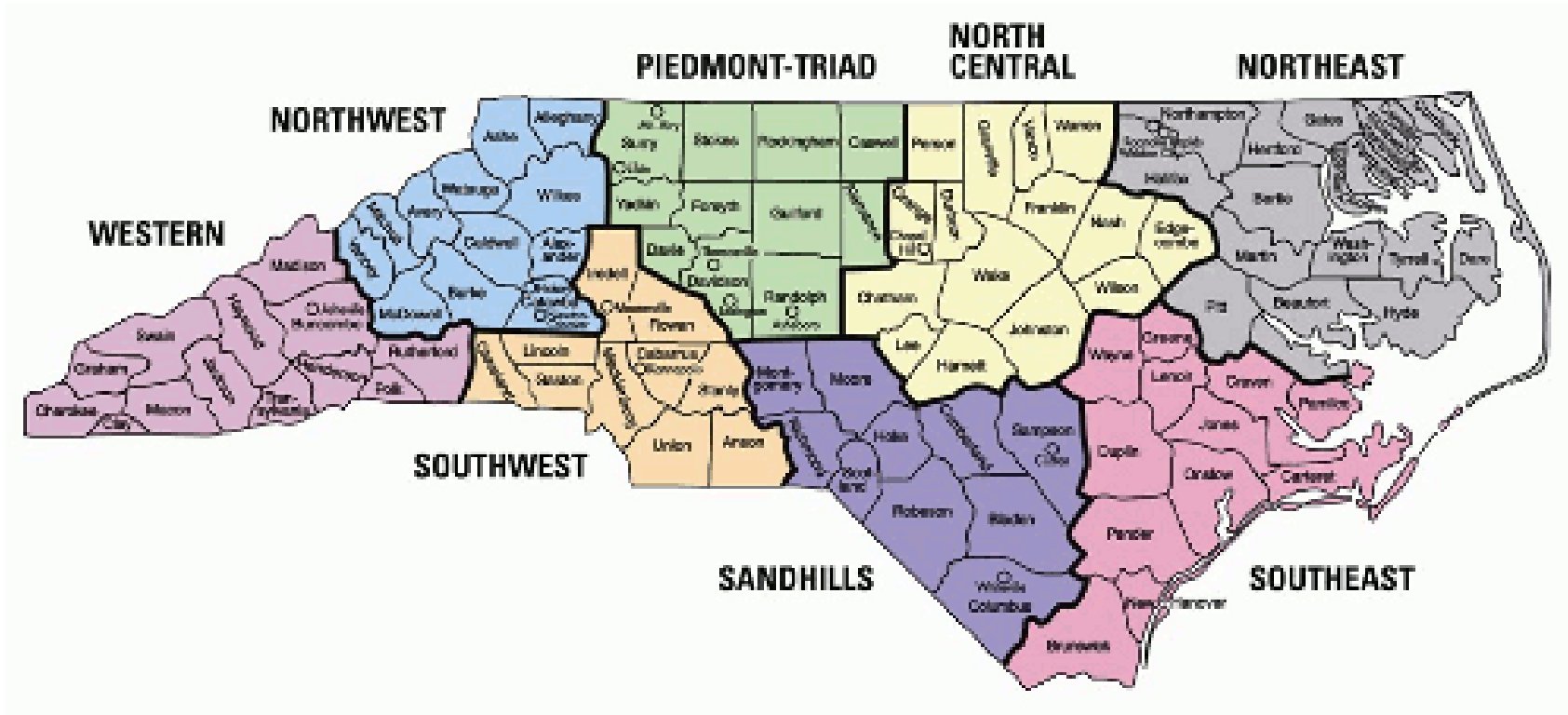

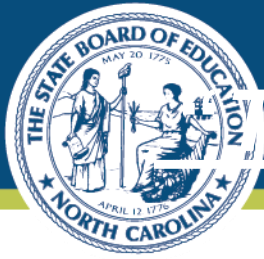
