Racial Terror Lynchings

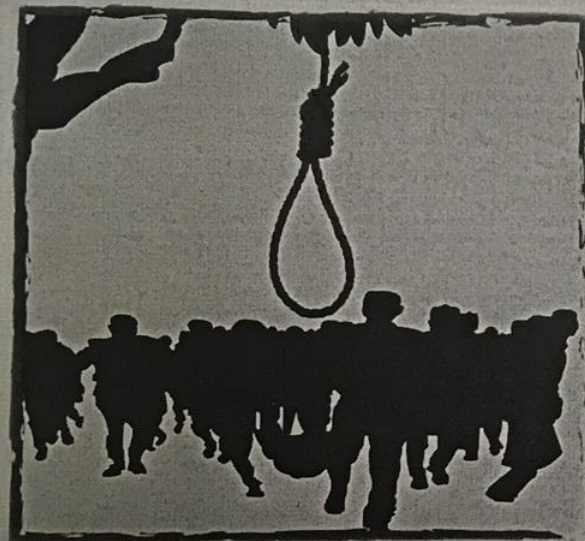
Racial terror lynchings were not limited to the South, but the Southern **states** had the most in the nation: over 4,000 between 1877 and 1950.

20+





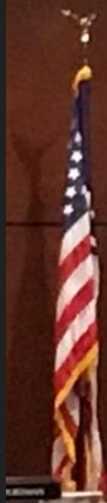
