## Request to Address the Board of Education

- The Board will establish a uniform time limit for each speaker (3 minutes).
- Only action items from the posted agenda may be discussed.
- To speak regarding an **action** item posted on the agenda, an individual must complete this form and submit it to the board secretary before the meeting is called to order by 3:00 p.m. the day of the monthly regular session of the Board of Education.
