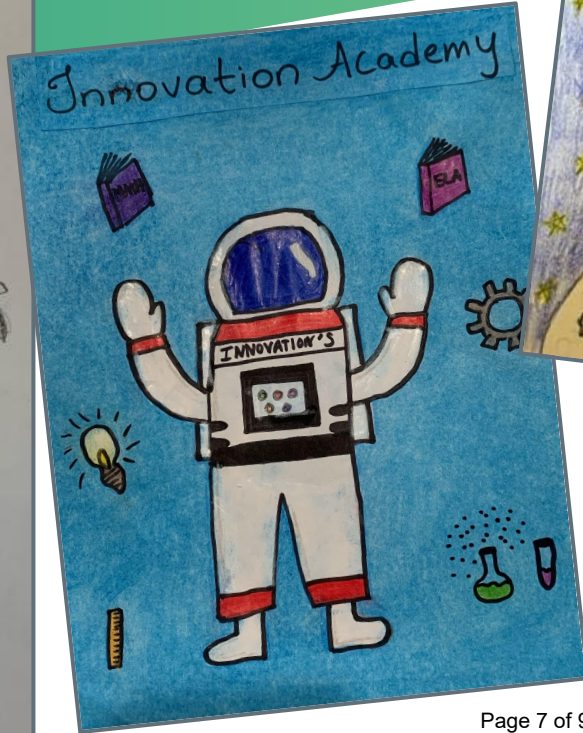


# 2021-2022—Our First Year
