It is with a heavy heart that I write my resignation from the Board of Education for the Southern Boone School District. In my time on this Board I have seen our District do wonderful things and educate many students to the best of our abilities in sometimes tumultuous and uncertain times. At this point in my tenure I feel as though a line has been crossed in the governance this Board provides and a lack of adherence to the Ethics standards required of Board Members in our own policy BBF. Specifically, I feel this Board has done a disservice to our “greatest concern” which must be “the educational welfare of **all students** attending public schools.”

Additionally, certain members of this Board have failed to adhere to this policy as it relates to:

- Becoming informed concerning the issues to be considered at each meeting;
- Refraining from using their Board position for the benefit of family members, or themselves;
- Rendering decisions based on facts and independent judgment rather than succumbing to the influence of individuals or special interest groups.

I cannot continue to lead a Board where I have little confidence in the dedication or foresight applied by the current make-up of the Board. I would implore the remaining members of the Board to examine their dedication and desire to serve this community. My resignation is effective immediately.
