Balancing Opportunities for In Person Learning Across Cohorts

Goal: Provide balance between cohort groups with regard to the number of in person learning days available.

Strategies:

- Limited use of “non-standard weeks” in service of creating greater balance.
- Reassignment of previously approved Remote Learning days on March 10 & 11 on the traditional calendar to January 4 & 5 to create additional opportunities for in person learning.
- Strategic placement of asynchronous learning days.



Asynchronous Learning Days

Goals:

- Provide teachers with necessary collaborative planning time.
- Provide students with supports to aid their success.
- Balance the need for this support structure with the strong desire to maximize in person learning opportunities for students.

Strategies:

- Add 2-3 additional asynchronous learning days to each calendar over the course of the Spring 2021 semester.
