Expanded Learning Opportunities Program (ELO-P)

- Provides funding for afterschool and summer school enrichment programs for transitional kindergarten (TK) through sixth grade as established by Assembly Bill 130.
- Designed to increase access to educational and enrichment services beyond our current After School Education and Safety (ASES) and Student Care offerings.
- FCUSD received \$2.5 M for the 2021-2022 ELO-P Entitlement.
 - May be carried over to next year
- FCUSD allocation for 2022-2023 has yet to be determined.

FCUSD Expanded Learning Opportunities Program Plan

- The ELO-P Plan describes program activities that will allow us to increase our service offerings in academics, wellness, and enrichment activities
- ASES, Student Care, and the ELO Program will be considered a single, comprehensive program.
- Funding provides unduplicated K-6 students and families the flexibility to participate in a free nine-hour school day based on their needs and interests.

Expanded Learning Program Plan Priorities

FCUSD Expanded Learning Opportunities Program

- Approximately 4,041 unduplicated students in TK - 6
- Goal is to serve 50% of these unduplicated students
- Currently serve about 1,081 total students in ASES and Student Care
 - Approximately 440 of our currently enrolled students are unduplicated
- All school sites will have ELO-P as comprehensive program with ASES and Student Care
- Title 1 schools will be the focus on increasing enrollment
- Will impact facilities and will have to use classrooms

- Ratios for ELO-P
 - TK - K is 10:1
 - 1st - 6th is 20:1
- Plan to grow programs pending additional staffing
 - Need to hire approximately 88 additional staff
