WHAT DOES HIGH-IMPACT TUTORING LOOK LIKE

As a North Carolina Education Corps high-impact literacy tutor you will:

- Lead tutoring sessions with 1 to 3 students at a time
- Work with the same students no less than 3 days/week
- Tutor each child or group for 30-45 minutes per session
- Tutor students in-person at their school during the school day

WHAT'S IN IT FOR YOU



MEANINGFUL WORK

From September 2021 to May 2022, corps members will provide high-impact early literacy tutoring to K-3 public school students, and strategic support to an NC public school unit.



MEANINGFUL RELATIONSHIPS

Corps members will collaborate with a community of peers in schools and districts across NC for real-time community building and problem solving, inspiring excellence in each other and the students they serve.

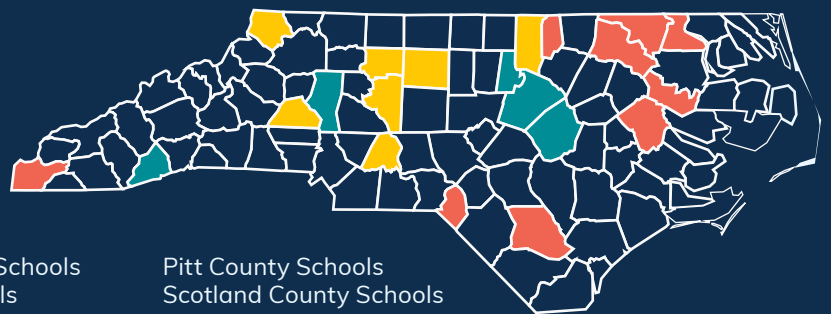


LIFE-CHANGING IMPACT

Corps members will have a site supervisor in the school district in which they serve and access to the NC Ed Corps staff who will help them navigate their experience, build skills, and connect with a community of changemakers.

Corps members will commit to eight months of service in a partner PSU. Corps members will help our state's youngest learners transition from 'learning to read' to 'reading to learn' and serve as high-impact early literacy tutors, grounded in the science of reading and reading instruction.
