Subject: Missouri School Board Association Board of Directors Representative

A. **Pertinent Facts:**

Joplin Schools BOE President, Rylee Hartwell, has been asked to serve and he is seeking an endorsement for the position of Missouri School Boards Association (MSBA) Board of Directors. The regional nomination requires an official endorsement of the local school board.

B. **Alignment:**

Strategic Goal 2.3.1: The District, with human resources and curriculum working together, will provide relevant and effective training experiences for teachers/staff, leaders, and BOE members to support district goals, and strengthen governance and practice.

Strategic Goal 3.2.1: The District will create and implement a community engagement and communications plan that increases the regional and state profile of Joplin Schools.

Strategic Goal 3.3.2: The District will grow community partnerships with local businesses and organizations to support student and staff engagement and success.

Responsibilities of the MSBA Board of Directors include:

- Have supervision, control and direction of the affairs of the Association.
- Establish policies or determine changes therein within the limits of the Bylaws, statement of beliefs and resolutions of the Association and pursue the purposes of the Association
- Have discretion in the disbursement of Association funds, and shall adopt such rules and regulations for the conduct of its business.
- Attend quarterly Board of Director meetings (January, April, July, and October)
- Attend Legislative Forum, Regional Meetings, Igniting Great Ideas Summit, and MSBA Annual Conference.
- Work collaboratively with the region's Regional Executive Committee Chair and Staff Liaison to support and promote the purpose and goals of MSBA, and to mobilize local school board members in the region to be enthusiastic advocates for public education.
